

Q Hi Kathleen,

How do you LOAD SOUND INTO a TVPAINT 10 FILE?



Use the CLIP Menu > Load Sound

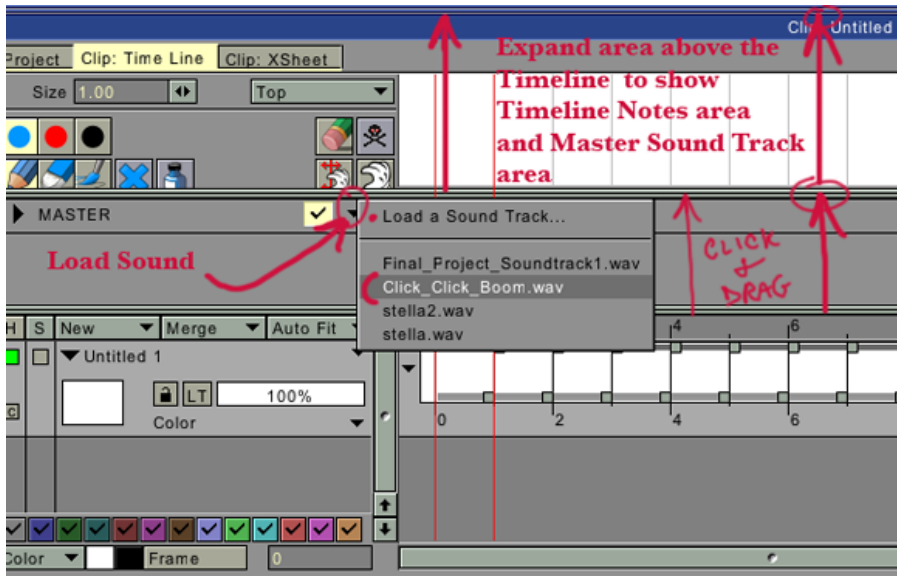
. Because the individual clip that is on the Timeline is where you want to add the soundtrack. (adding sound to a "Project" is something else.

A "Project" in TVPaint terms can contain multiple Clips , but that's a topic for another day)

But There is ANOTHER WAY to import (load) sound into a TVP timeline: Keep reading

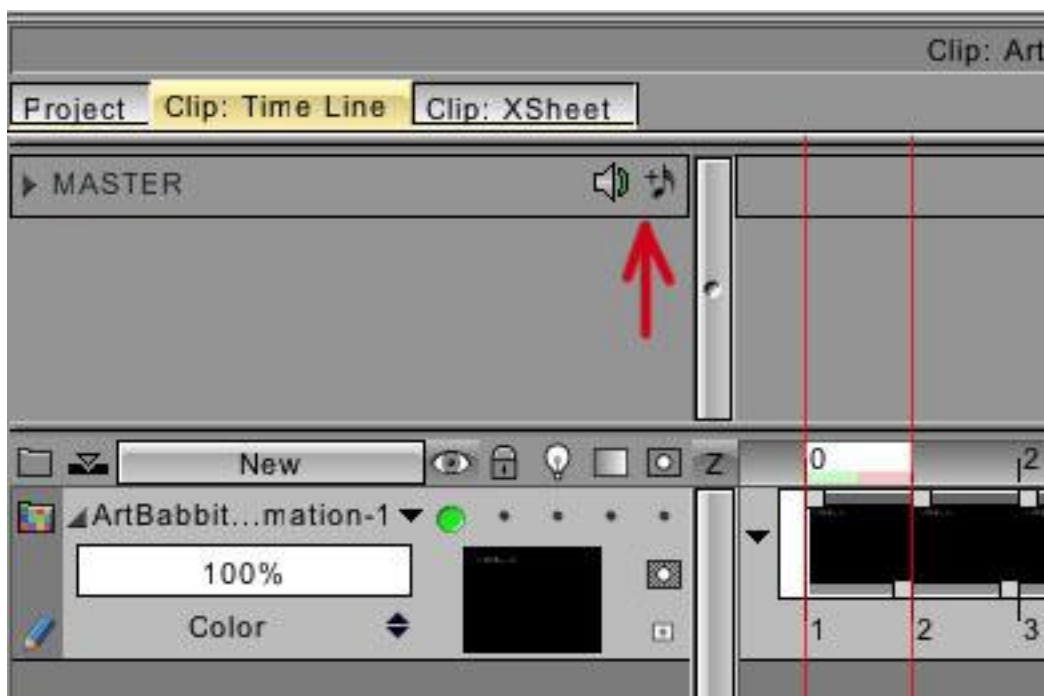
However, the other method to load the sound in TVPaint is to Load the sound file into the Soundtrack area above the Timeline .

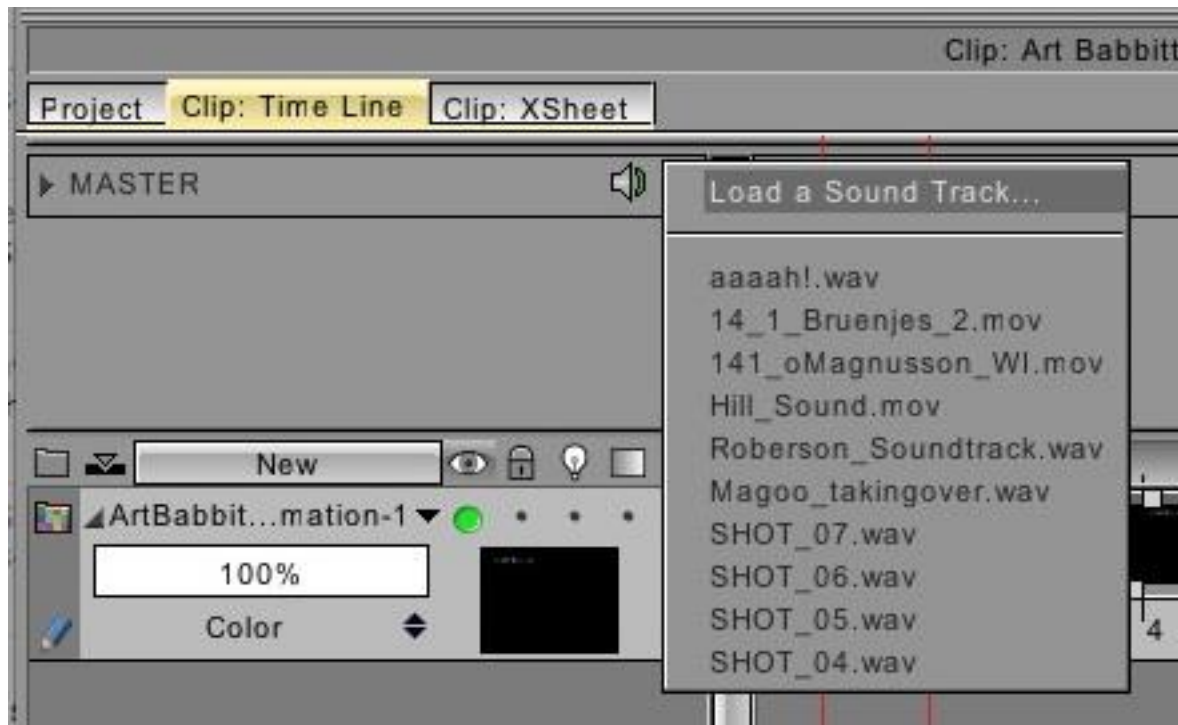
To reveal the Soundtrack area above the timeline you click and drag on the double-thick line above the Timeline to expand the Soundtrack area (and another optional area called Timeline Notes above that if you want to use it , but that's another topic ...) -



Then do this:

In the Soundtrack area above the Timeline click next to the little musical note icon 🎵 and select "Load Sound Track" . When the file directory opens navigate to the soundtrack (.wav file or .mp3 file) that you want to load and select it .

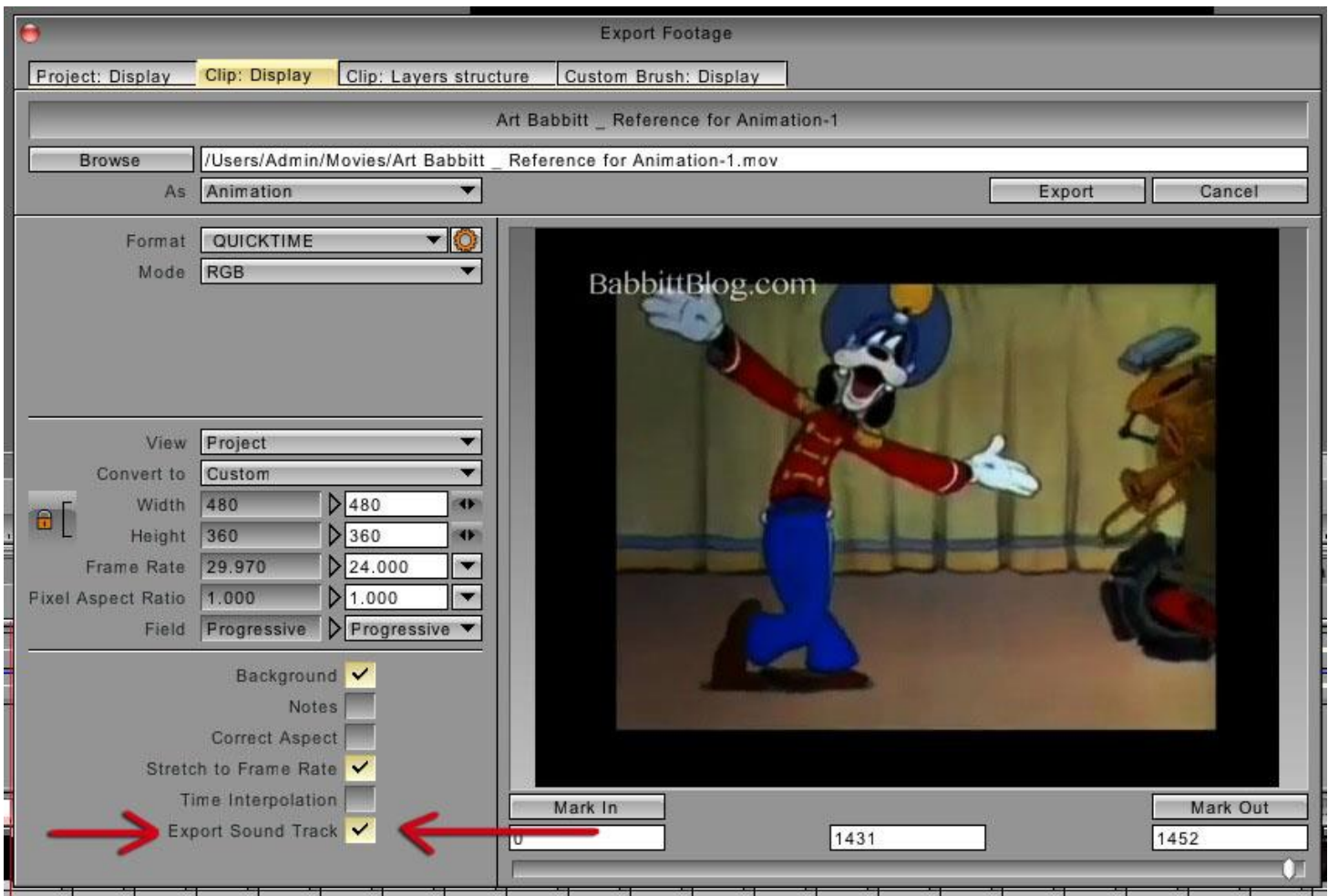

I do not understand what I am doing wrong with my animation. When I add sound in TVPaint it shows the animation with the sound, but when I export it... the animation disappears and the sound is left. Is there something else I am suppose to do to make them both show up when I export it?

ANSWER:

"when you're exporting the clip from tvp, make sure the export sound track box is checked. its located above the export button. (go to file, click export to, then at the bottom about the export button make sure export sound track is checked)"
