

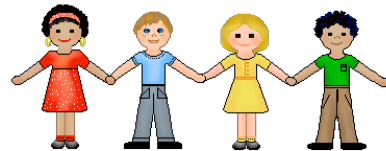
Becoming a Love and Logic Parent...
