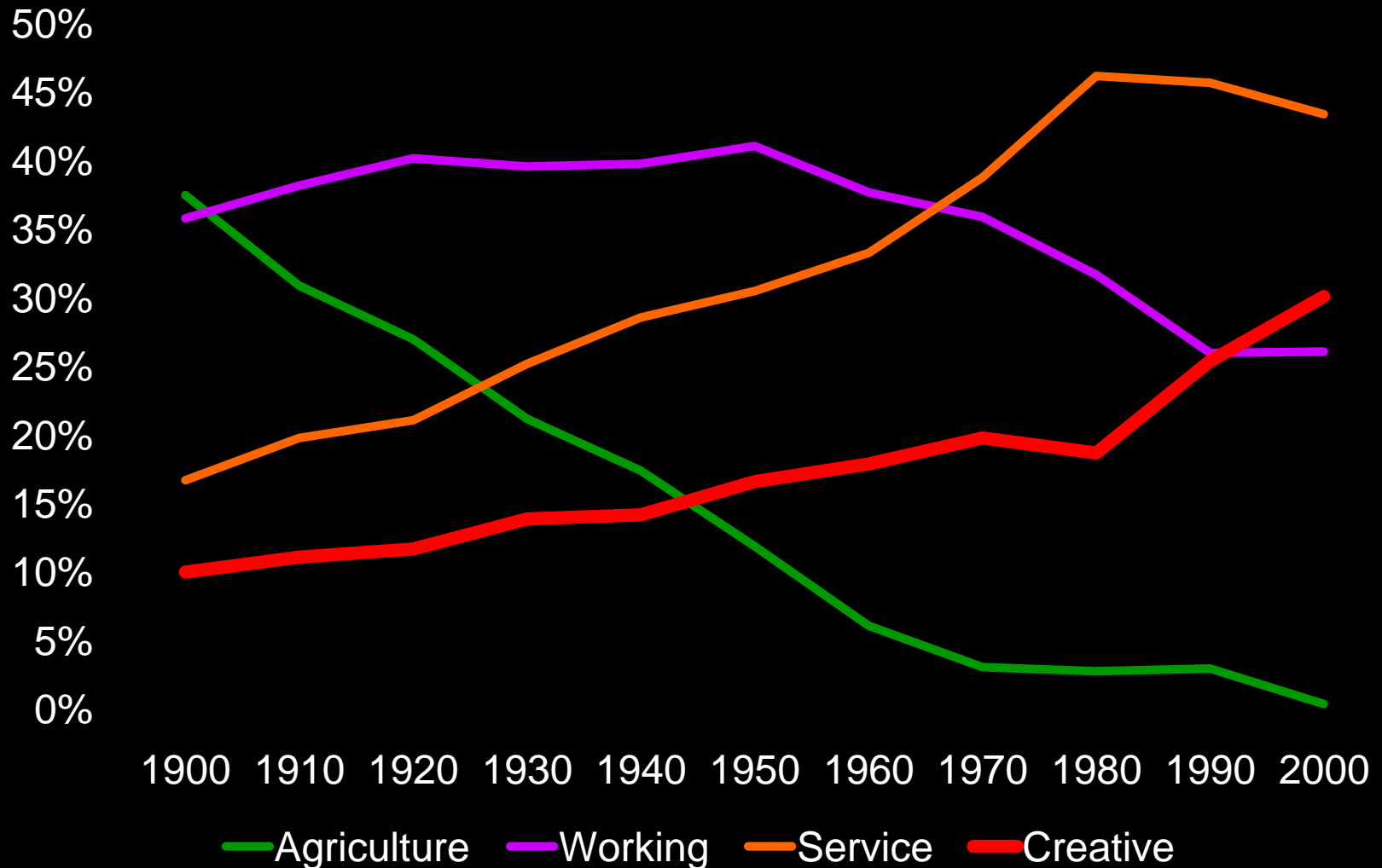
EMPLOYMENT BY SECTOR United States, 1980 to 2009



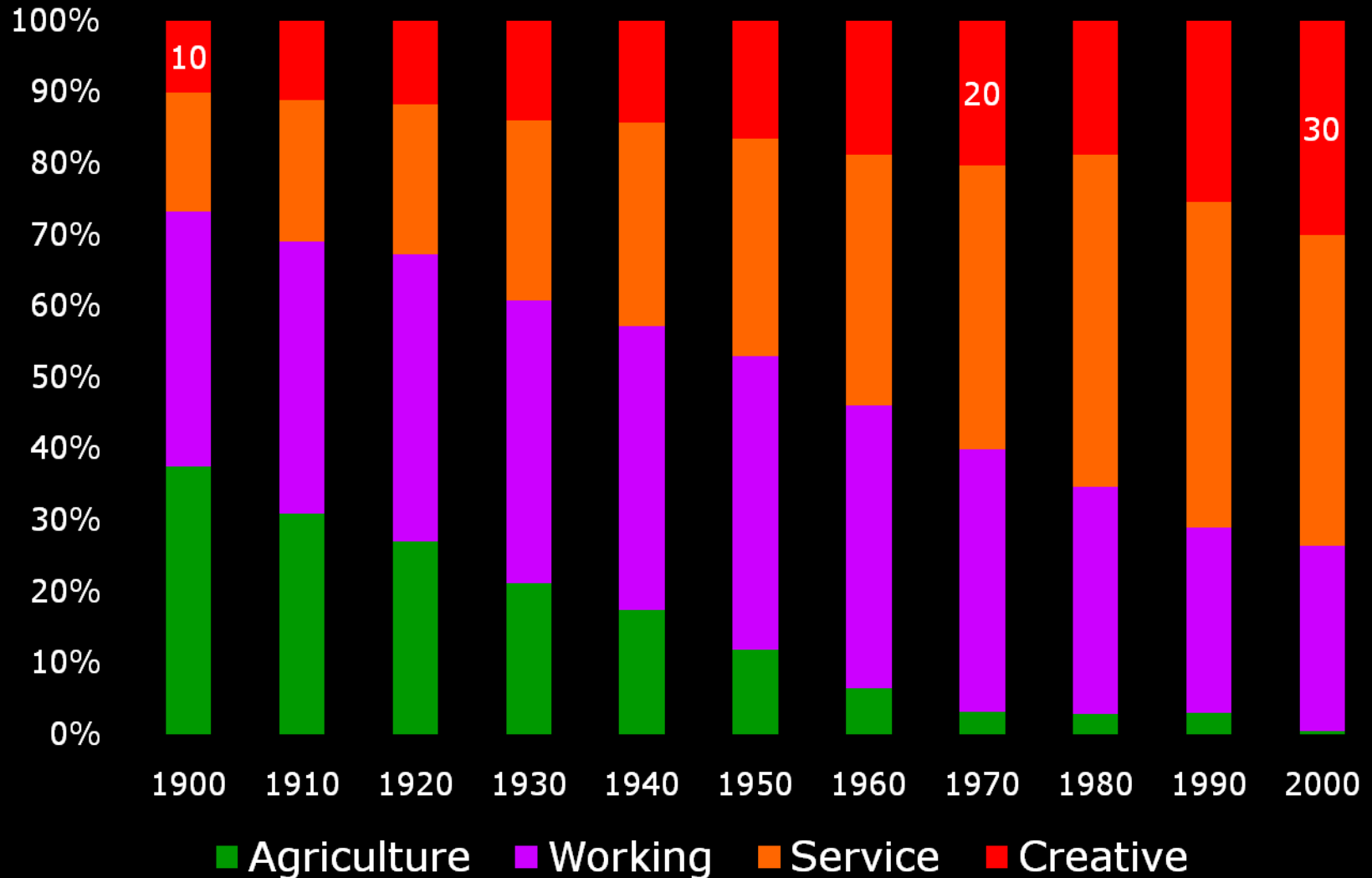
Kentucky Workforce Projections, 2006-2016

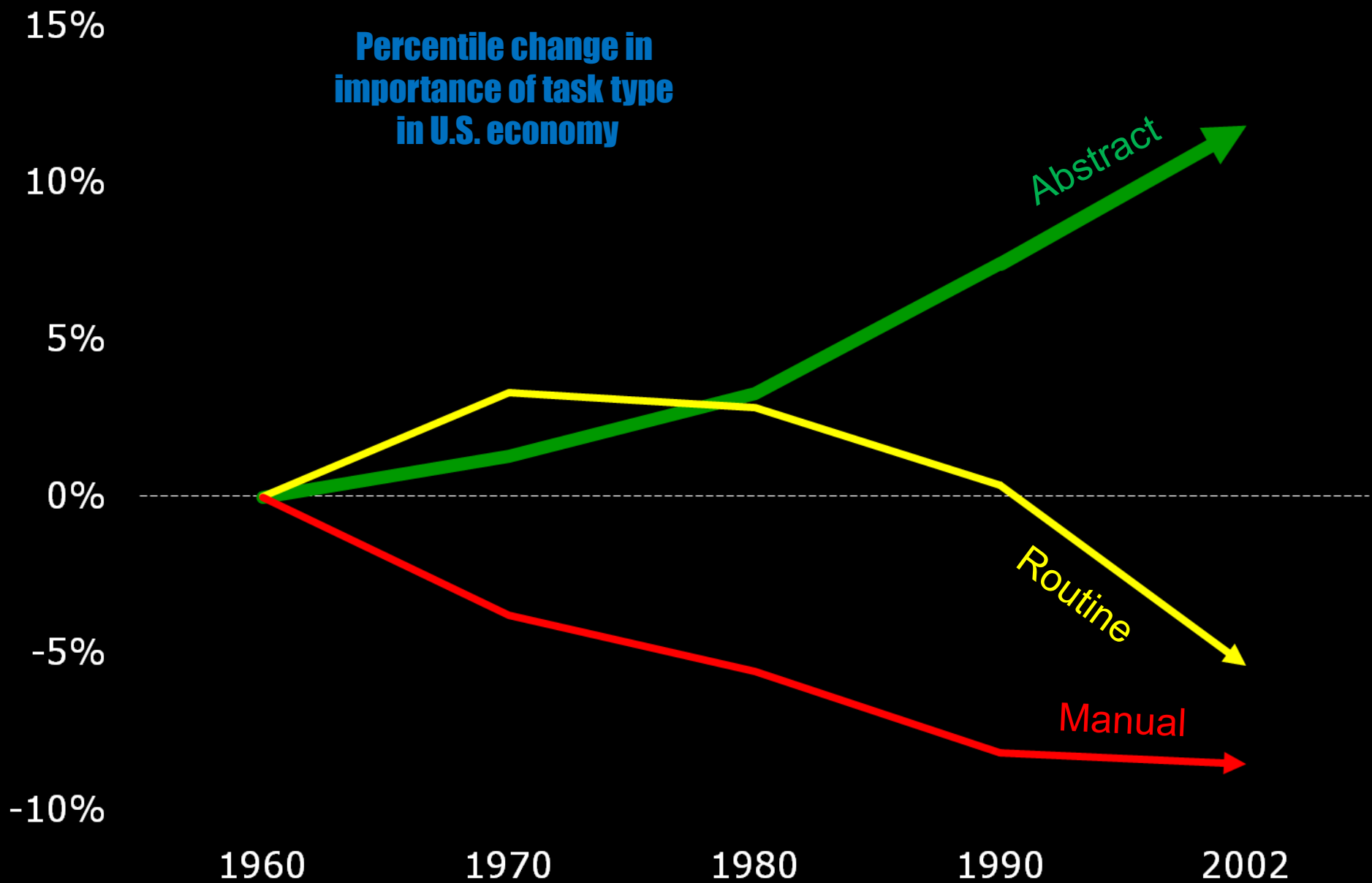

Project-based learning at DHS draws national attention

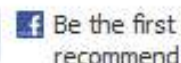
What has been going on in a Danville High School classroom drew some national attention Wednesday.

Ninth-grade students in project-based learning classroom showed off work combining science and English included former Kentucky Commissioner of Education Gene Wilhoit. Wilhoit, now is the executive director of the Washington, D.C.-based Council of Chief State School Officers.

The science portion of the first-year class is taught by Danville High School teacher Derek Otto handling the English curriculum. For two class periods, students, often in groups, are asked to use content and skills to solve problems that often don't have clear answers and then present and defend their conclusions.

One project required students to read a book and make a map that represented elements of the story and write about the story. However, students also were required to make sure that all

were in balance and be able to show the trigonometry to explain why.

Just Doing It: Danville's Bate Middle stressing 'project-based' education

When you enter Vicky Ramey's sixth-grade communication class at Bate Middle School, you don't notice anything different or unusual about the classroom or the students in it.

The blackboard has writing on it. Artwork and posters are on the wall. A teacher is talking to the students, both collectively and individually.

But if you hang around the room long enough, you realize both the students and their teacher are involved in an innovative kind of learning process. The students and Ramey will gladly clue you in on what makes their class different from others.

"Basically, what we are doing in this class doesn't come from a book," said student Daniel McAllister. "It's about doing and experiencing than it is about sitting down and reading a book."

Some of that "doing and experiencing" for Daniel has included trips to the Boyle County Courthouse, where he observed first-hand the inner-working of local government judicial systems, and to Centre College, where he saw academics and artists in action.
