BCLUW Schools has purchased 8e6 appliances and licensing <http://www.m86security.com/> to handle filtering on the laptops. Currently all users receive the same level of filtering, but I have also used WorkGroup Manager at the user level to restrict applications when necessary.

iChat

BCLUW -- As part of our training from Apple Computer, we learned how to use iChat to transfer documents & find that very useful (custodial staff indicated to me that paper trash collection is down by 75% in the first few weeks of school). So far, we've just used Bonjour to see users on the iChat network, but I now have iChat server setup and have worked with my AEA Network consultant to open up appropriate ports. We should now be able to pre-populate buddy lists from the server. Our school counselor commented to me that he's "getting a lot more counseling done" because students are able to use iChat.

BCLUW -- We implemented Google Apps ( <http://google.com/a/edu> ) over a year ago, and have been very happy with it. Students have access to world-class email service 24/7 in addition to online document storage and collaboration tools. All this at no cost to the district!

SHCSD We are in the process of rolling this out this year. With the addition of the new tools Google Mail allows the districts to monitor and archive emails.

Van Meter ~~ We have had a large amount of issues with machines not having the proper admin rights. I have had to reimage a lot of machines due to admin rights and not being able to log in. I am guessing some might have been done to get it done as I am not the "techie" when sending out quick fix packages. Once imaged, they have worked fine. We also had errors when we used ARD as TC imaged using the wrong admin user on the laptops.

One really odd thing is that we have the machines set to require login once they close their lids. The odd thing is that they randomly get logged in as VMADMIN. The students cannot log in and I have to do it for them. Also, when they log out, it automatically logs them in as VMADMIN without requiring a password. This also happens when they restart their machine. The settings just seem to be lost.

Vic Jaras sent me the Google SketchUp codes for individual installs on laptops. Each district can have up to 400 installs, Vic can get more if needed. Please visit with me to get you codes. I need to keep track of who takes a number and how many installs they are going to have. --Karl Hehr South Hamilton
