http://www.projectorcentral.com/pdf/projector_manual_3703.pdf: never-before-seen instructions for my LCD projector. Learned: I should find my remote control and use it. It will also tell you how long since the filter was last changed! It also claims that it will inform you when the air filter needs cleaning. I *think* this is for the correct model... will check. Maybe I have a cheaper one and I need to get a vacuum cleaner. ;-)

They also have a suggested orientation for viewing full page docs, which I should try out. I also learned I should try dropping the resolution if I want it to pick up hand movements better. I was also happy to discover that they are now selling an official "height extension" (not that I'll actually buy it, but glad to see validation that the height is an actual issue rather than a "personal problem") and that they have released a new version of the system software: those were the two biggest reservations I had with the device.
