

Student Macbooks will be completely erased, re-imaged, and updated over the summer months.

All student files copied or synced to the network will be erased after June 24, 2011.

Students who wish to carry files over to the 2011-2012 school year are responsible for backing them up on a personal backup device. (USB drive, CD-DVD Media, iPod)

Student files on the Macbook and District Network Storage Space will not be carried over to the new school year.

You will not have access to your Macbook after it is handed in.

Please see below for backup instructions for a USB storage device or CD/DVD

Copy to a USB device

Plug in your USB memory device. Open a new Finder window. Click on Macintosh HD. Double click the Users Folder.

The Library Folder. Found in your Home folder.

If you don't want to backup your whole Home folder, or don't have room, you can backup individual folders.

Backup this folder if you want your Safari Bookmarks

Backup this file if you want your stickies

The house icon with your username on it contains all your "stuff"....Drag that icon to your USB drive icon to copy all your "stuff" to that drive. After the copy has finished double check that your files copied to the drive.

Your Documents should be here, backup this file if you want to keep them.

Backing up to a CD or DVD

Insert a blank CD or DVD. The media will show as an icon on your desktop. Drag your Home folder or the files/folders you want to keep on top of your CD or DVD icon

Double click on the CD or DVD icon. Click Burn.
