

# Connecting the Macbook to Your Home Internet

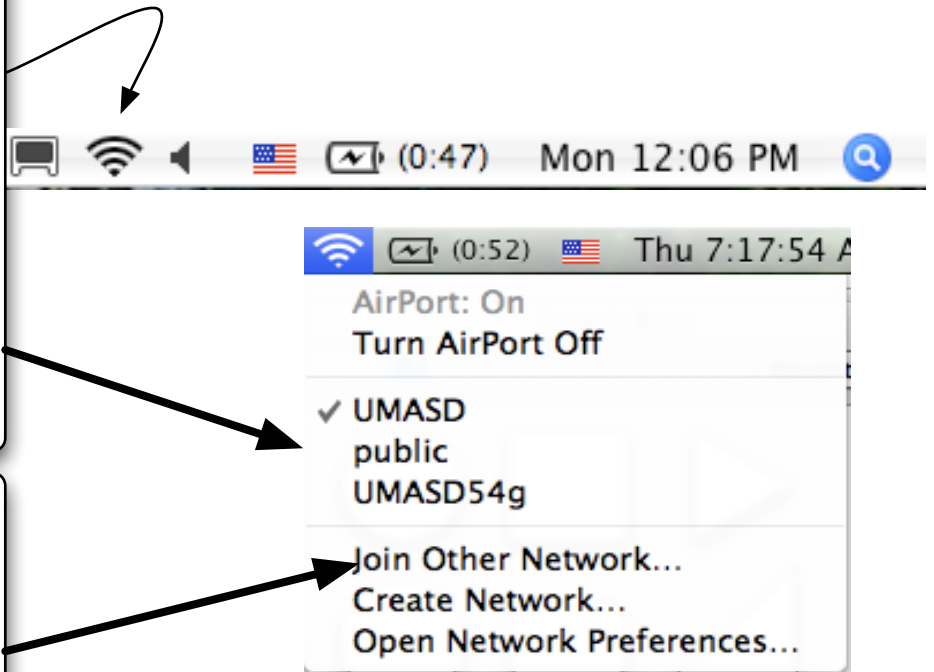
## WIRELESS Home Internet Connection

1. Click on the Wireless Connection icon. (The fan)
2. Choose YOUR wireless network name.
3. Enter a password or pass key phrase if necessary.
4. Launch a web browser. (Safari, Firefox)
5. If you cannot connect, restart your Macbook and try again.

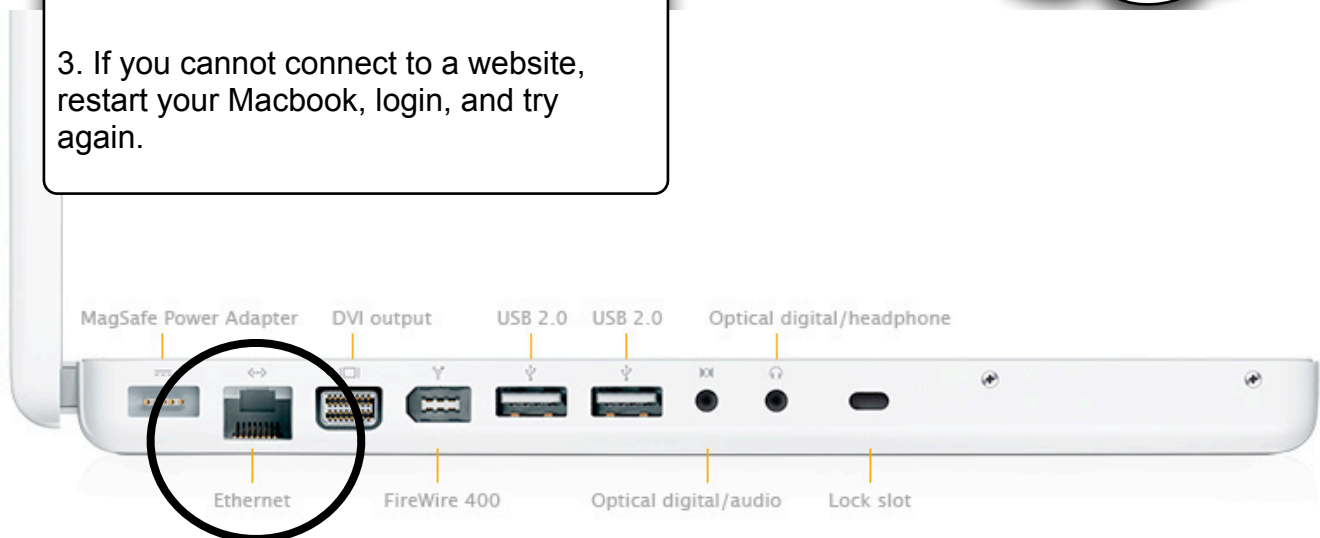
If your Wireless Connection at home contains a hidden SSID click **Other...** and type in your wireless network name exactly, enter a passkey if needed. You can also use the **Join Other Network** function to select your wireless security.

## WIRED Home Internet Connections

1. Connect your RJ45 ethernet patch cable to your Ethernet port. See Below.
2. Launch a web browser
3. If you cannot connect to a website, restart your Macbook, login, and try again.
