

# iMovie

## Filming/Recording

- In order to record an video/movie using the mac books using iMovie, Move the tab button from the scissors toward the camera. Or Click the small video camera button and options will appear where you can record with “Built in Time-Lapse”
  - Following that a button will appear on the screen where it says “Record with iSight”.
    - By pressing that the small camera on the top of the Mac will start to record.
    - In order to stop recording, press the “Record with iSight button again”
- You can also upload videos into iMovie with a digital camera that is connected to the Mac
  - When the Camera is connected, you can record and it will upload to the computer.
  - If the movie is already finish, you can click “File, Import” and upload the movie.

## Putting your movie together.

- Every time you record something it records as a clip and appears on the right hand side of the screen. Each clip will be labeled “Clip #”.
  - From here you can drag the clips from the left hand side to the bottom section underneath everything, which will be empty.
    - Here is where you can arrange the clips in any order that you wish.

## Editing your movie.

- In order to edit your movie go to the editing tab on the right hand side of the screen.
  - There several options will appear, of Title, Transactions, Video Editing and Audio Editing.
    - Each one has several different options that creates special effects for each one.
    - In order to apply the setting of effects, clip on the clip with the portion that you want to edit.

- Then under the screen where the video is shown there are 2 arrows next to each other. The first arrow is where you want to start to apply the editing while the second one can be dragged to where you wish stop applying the edit to.
  - The selected area will appear as yellow opposed to the normal blue color.
- In order to add transitions between clips, click on a transition and then drag in between the two clips that you wish for the transition to be in.
- You can add songs using iTunes or Garage Band for background music in your movie.

## Viewing your finished movie.

- Once you have finished your movie, you are to click on the white Play button with a black surrounding on it in order to view it in full screen.
- You can also show the video in another program by clicking “Share” and selecting Ex: Quicktime
