

The Anti-corruption Knowledge Café

Please grab your coffee (5 minutes) and come straight to the Anti-corruption Café. Following a brief introduction by your Café moderator Monjurul KABIR (10 minutes), you are expected to join a café table (phase I) of your preference immediately. Each table will be supported by a table host. A market place session will then initiate a period of sharing wisdom and insights in a whole group conversation. The Café is dedicated to discuss and propose a follow-up agenda of the 3rd UNDP Global Anti-corruption Community of Practice Meeting.



Phase I: The Café Talk (11.15-12.00)

Every 15 minutes 50% of the Café Table participants will move to the next table (Table A>B>C>A)

Table A - Time Zone: Participants will discuss and capture follow-up agenda including implementation strategy. Innovative thoughts and ideas are particularly welcome! **Key Questions:** What are 5 'quick wins' and 5 'short/medium-term' activities that you would recommend for this Anti-corruption Community of Practice?

Table B - Theme Park: Participants will propose, discuss, and, capture some of the emerging corruption/anti-corruption issues and newer trends for specific follow-up. Deeper understanding and appreciation of field realities are especially relevant! **Key Question:** What are 5 key emerging anti-corruption themes/trends that you wish the AC-CoP to address?

Table C - Melting Pot (Global-Regional-National): Participants will discuss and capture effective ways to build stronger synergies and functional relations between global/regional, and, national/country perspectives around a common set of anti-corruption programming ideas/strategies, and/or outputs. **Key Question:** How can we improve and strengthen our existing Global-Regional-National work processes? Discuss at least 5 changes you can believe in!



Phase II: The Market Place (12.00-12.45 PM)

The market place (collective wisdom) session will deliberate on the ideas/thoughts/action points generated at different café tables. The Host/Moderator will facilitate capturing the follow-up AC-CoP agenda for action.
