How to use the resource

Create an Account

- Click on “Sign Up”
- Input your name, email, and password. Click on “Create account”
- Confirm your email: sign in to your email account and open the BetterLesson message.
- Click on the “Click here to confirm your account” link

Navigate the Website

- Type a keyword into the search bar. For example, “trigonometric identities”.
- Use the navigation panel on the right to narrow your search by grade level and subject.
- Many lessons contain lesson objectives, lesson overviews, and resources that can be downloaded for use.
- There are various icons that may appear: For example, folder icons contain unit plans, clipboard icons contain lesson plans, green booklet icons contain entire course plans.
- On the top toolbar, you can also select the “Questions” tab, to access educational questions and answers posted by other members.
