Description:

Edmodo is a free and educational platform similar to Facebook and used by teachers, students, and parents. Teachers can post notes, alerts, assignments, quizzes and polls. Teachers can also create groups for their students in which they can post discussions, events, reminders, grades, and reward badges for their students.

How to use the resource:

Teachers:

- Sign up as a teacher, create a group and invite your students.
- Start distributing notes, assignments, and quizzes, and share the group code with your students to allow them to communicate and collaborate.

Students:

- Sign up as a student and join your class group with the group code shared by your teacher.
- Communicate with your classmates, submit assignments, view your grades/progress, and keep up with your planner.

Parents:

- Sign up as a parent and join your child's class group with the group code shared by the teacher.
- Stay up to date about your child's assignments, grades, upcoming events, and more.
