

(18) You should wear a seat belt, because if you crash, the seat belt stops you from continuing ~~to~~ ^{to} go ~~to~~ forward. When someone wears a seat belt, the seat belt acts as an outside force stopping him/her from continuing in the way ~~to~~ ^{to} they were going. If he/she is not wearing a seat belt, there is nothing to stop them ~~from~~ from crashing into the windshield. The car and person are going the same velocity. When the car crashes its velocity becomes zero, but the person still has that same amount of velocity.
