

Tip Your Editor

Editors can play an important, often thankless role in the writing process. For the editors who have helped you with your context report(CR), this is an **optional*** opportunity to “spread some love” their way by requesting they receive some extra credit based on how helpful they were with your writing. If you choose to do this, you need to do:

1. Review your editors’ suggestions and revise your context report based on their feedback.
2. For each editor that you feel contributed to your efforts, complete the form below.
