The reflection should be written in 3rd person.

Margins are 1" (inch) on top, bottom, left and right side of each page. Times New Roman 12 Font is to be used. Indentions are to be five (5) spaces. INTASC Portfolio Reflection Rubric will be used to evaluate each reflection. Grammar and content will be evaluated. Opportunity to edit and resubmit will be provided.

Each REFLECTION should be no longer than two (2) pages. Except for INTASC Standard #1. All five (5) components should be present. The five (5) components are:

Introduction (1 paragraph)

- 1) Introduction to the INTASC Standard
- 2) Brief description of the Class associated with this INTASC Standard
- 3) Brief description of the Artifact associated with this INTASC Standard

Body of the Reflection

- 4) **Explanation of how completing the Artifact made an impact – past (when it was assigned), present (during student teaching), future (when teaching in a classroom) - on the candidate. The reflection should tell the Artifact's affect when addressing the associated INTASC Standard.**
 - Explain how the Artifact was perceived when assigned
 - Explain how the Artifact may be having an impact during Student Teaching
