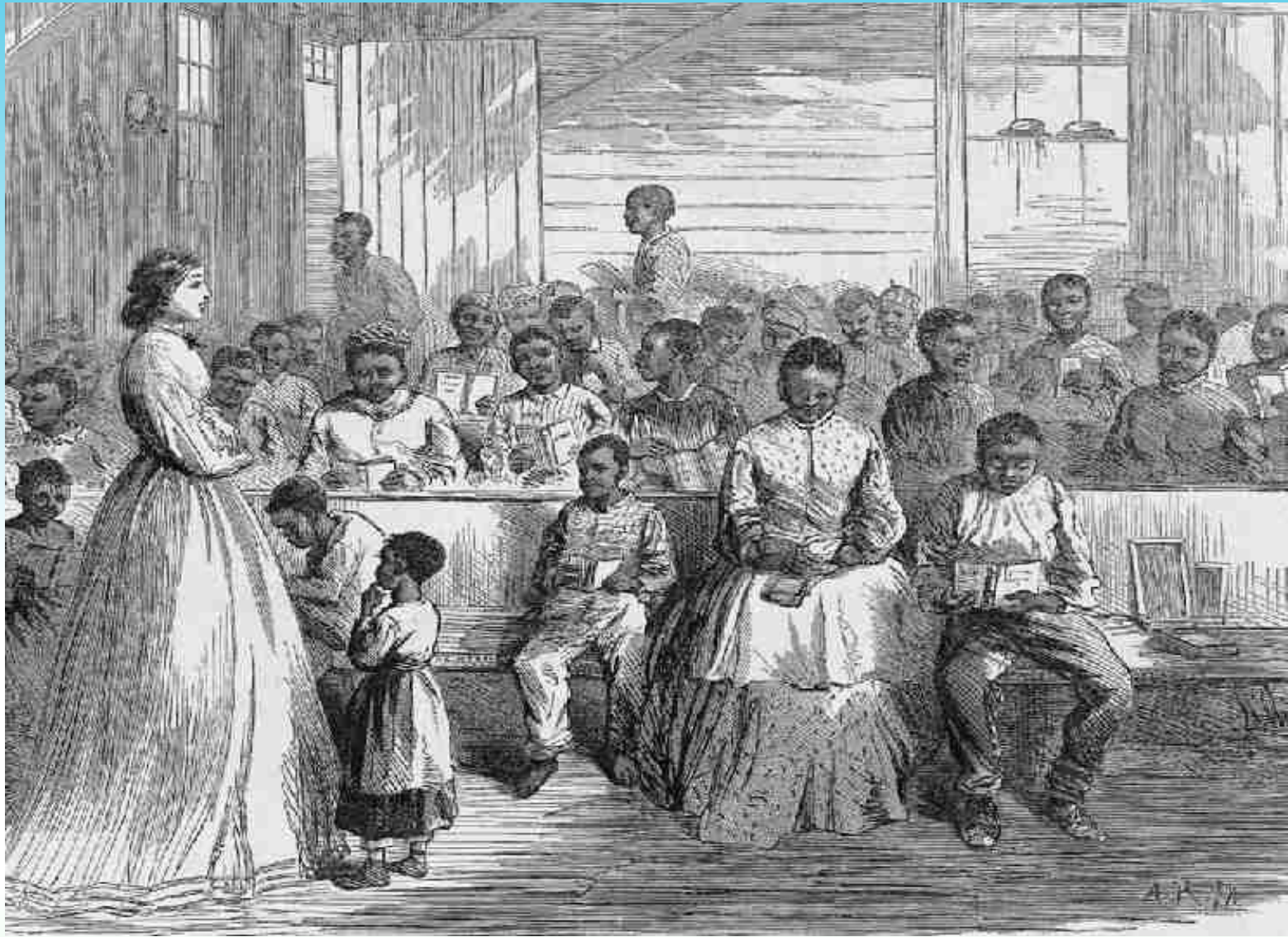

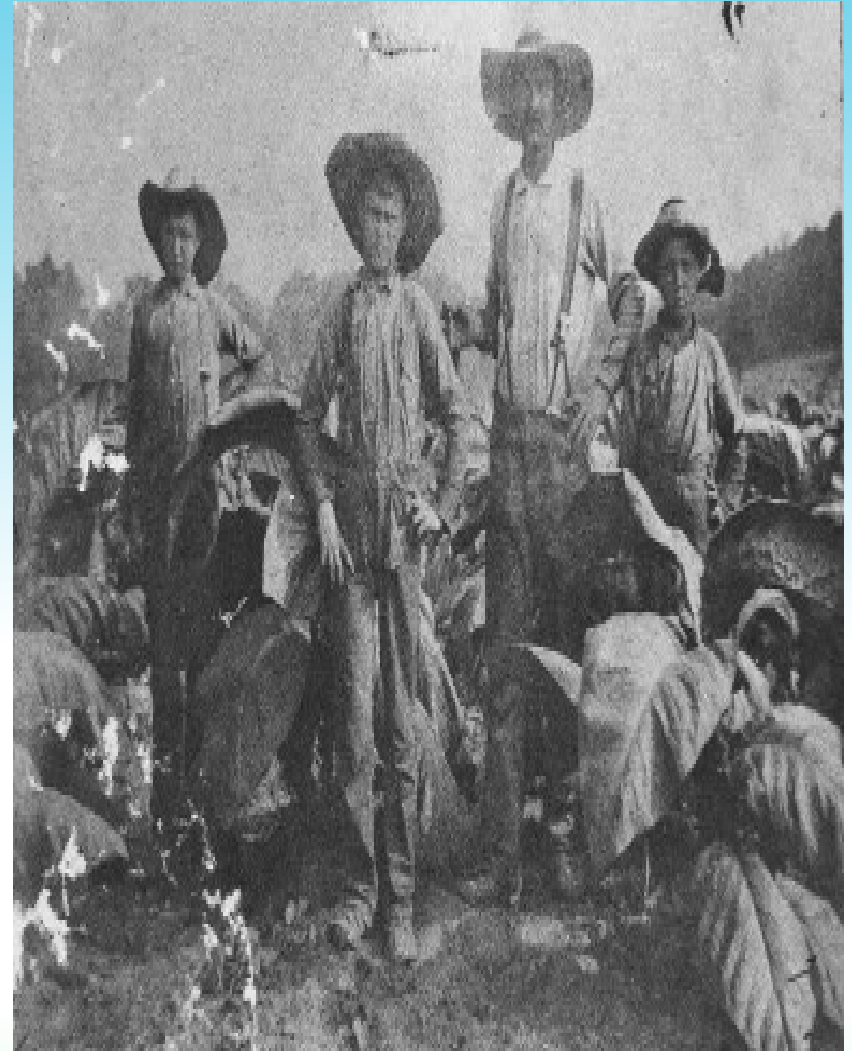

Pictured above is, a newspaper article that shows the thoughts toward black freedom rights.

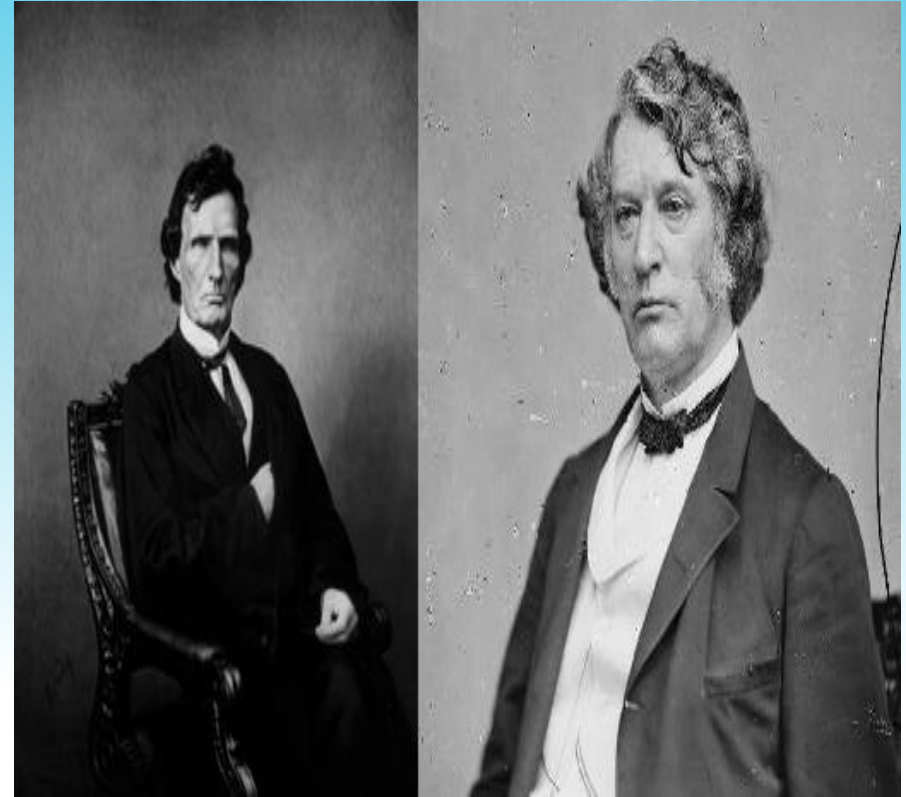


both blacks and white used "sharecropping" during reconstruction.

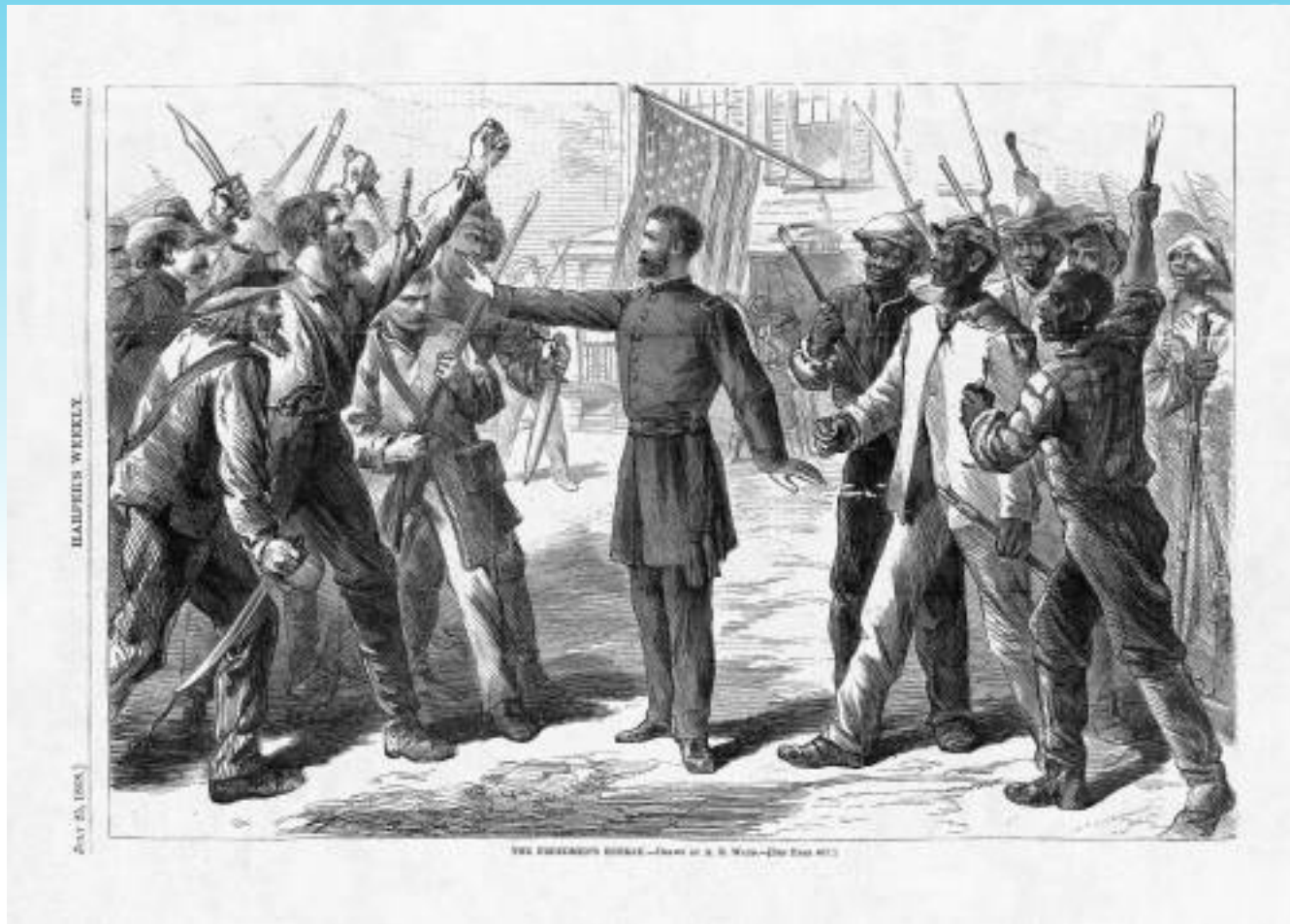




blacks outside of a one-room-schoolhouse.

this shows them repairing the union.

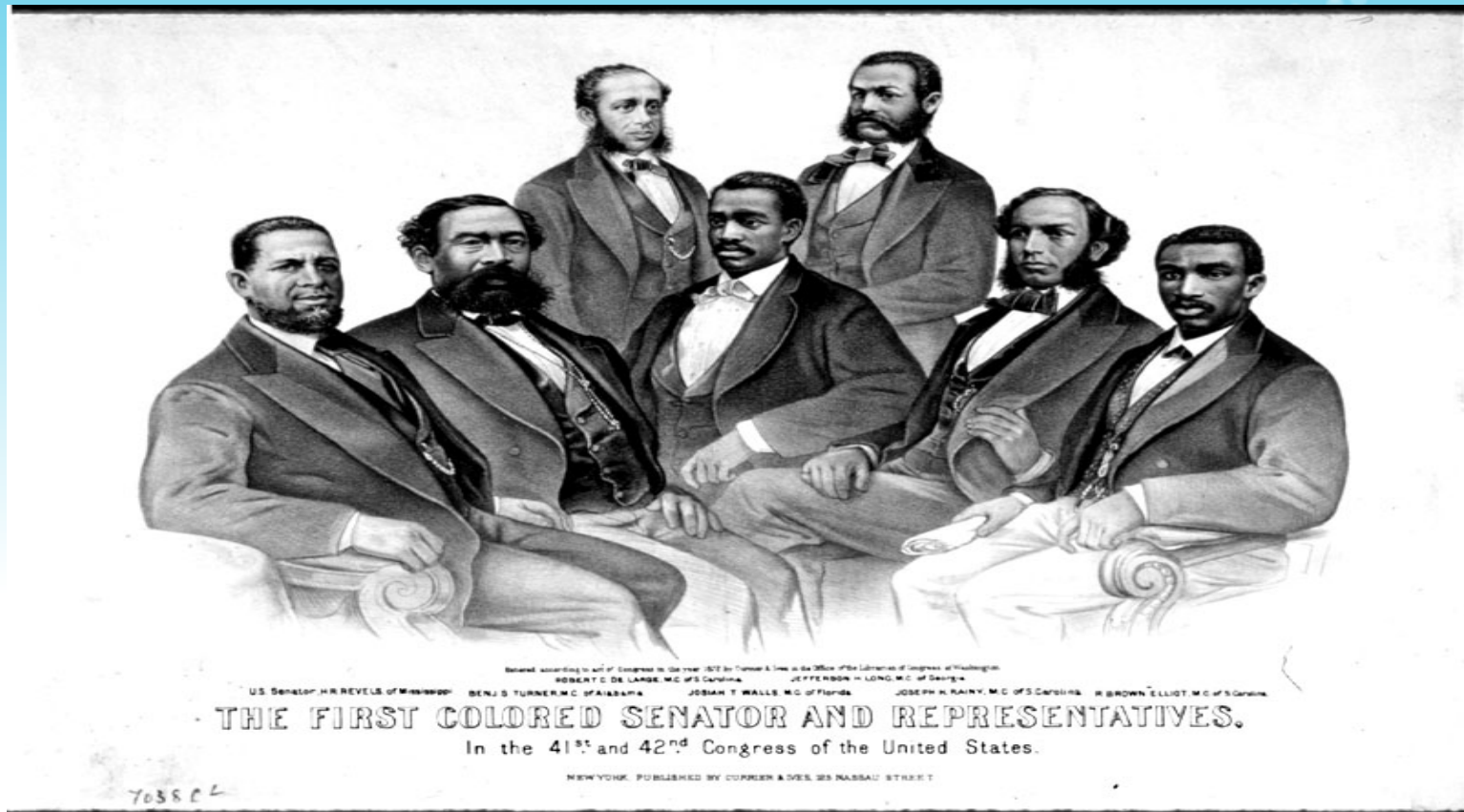


on the left is Johnson
