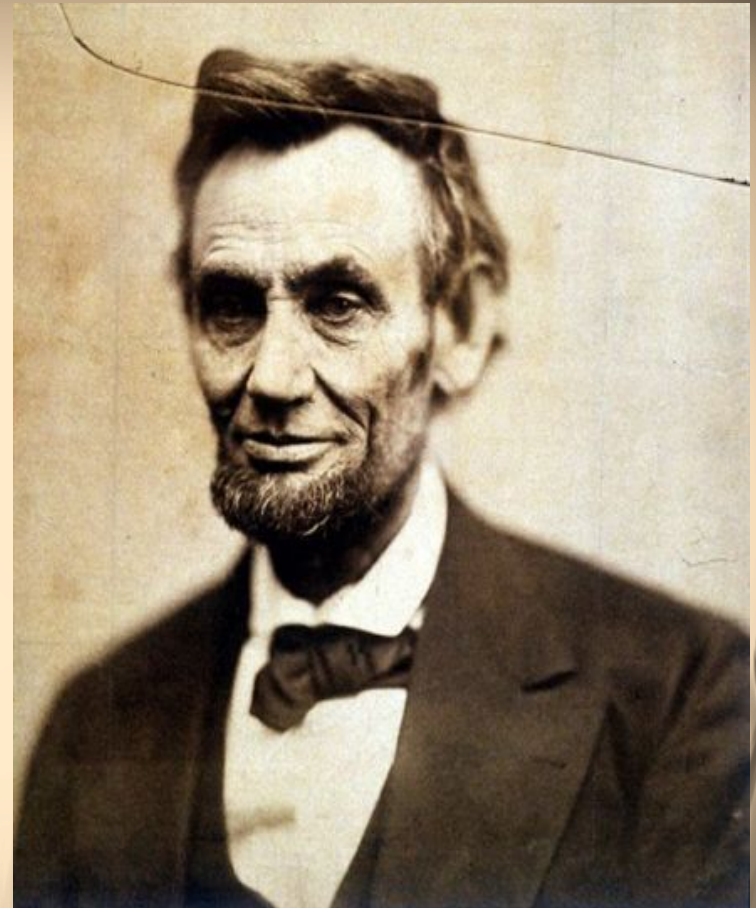


Civil War Reconstruction

to succeed.

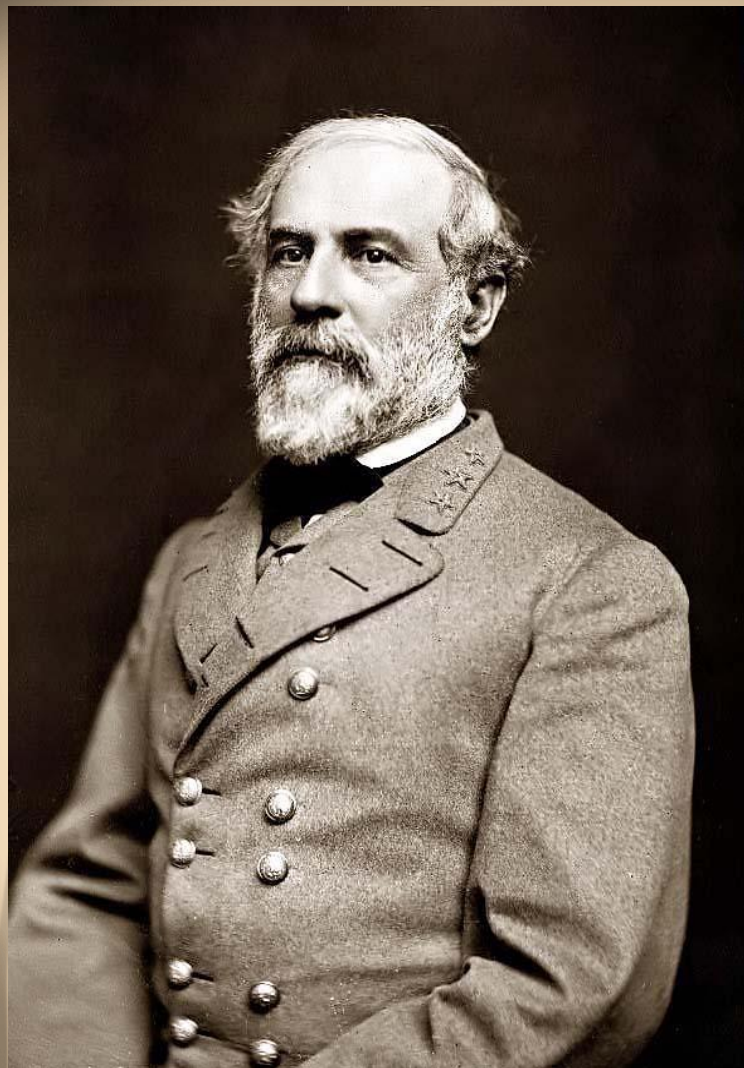




Ku Klux Klan

owner.

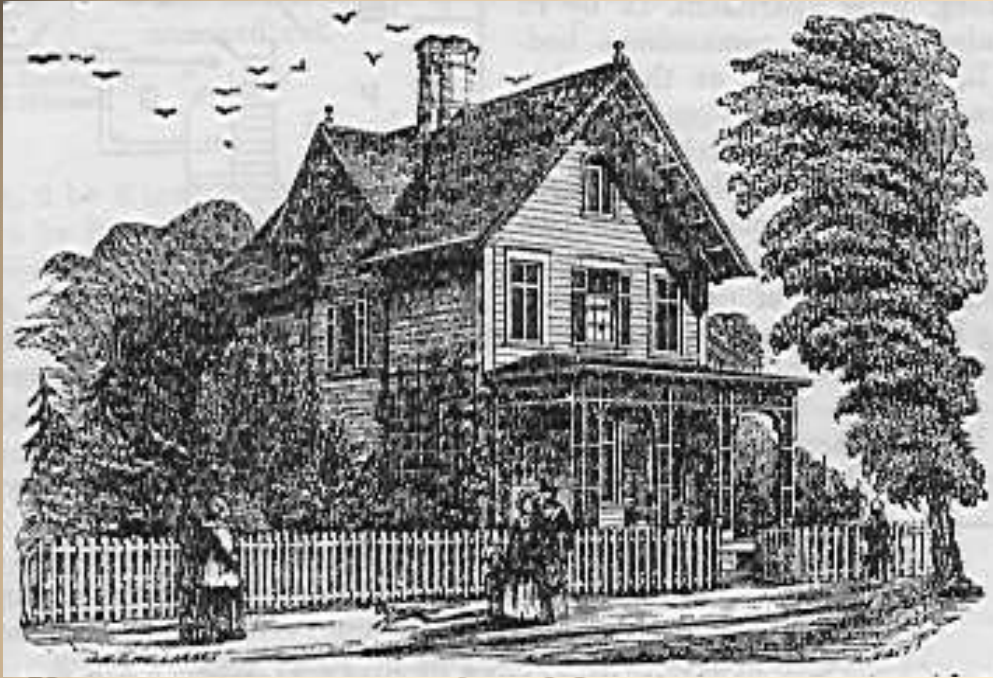




Free African

the Civil War.





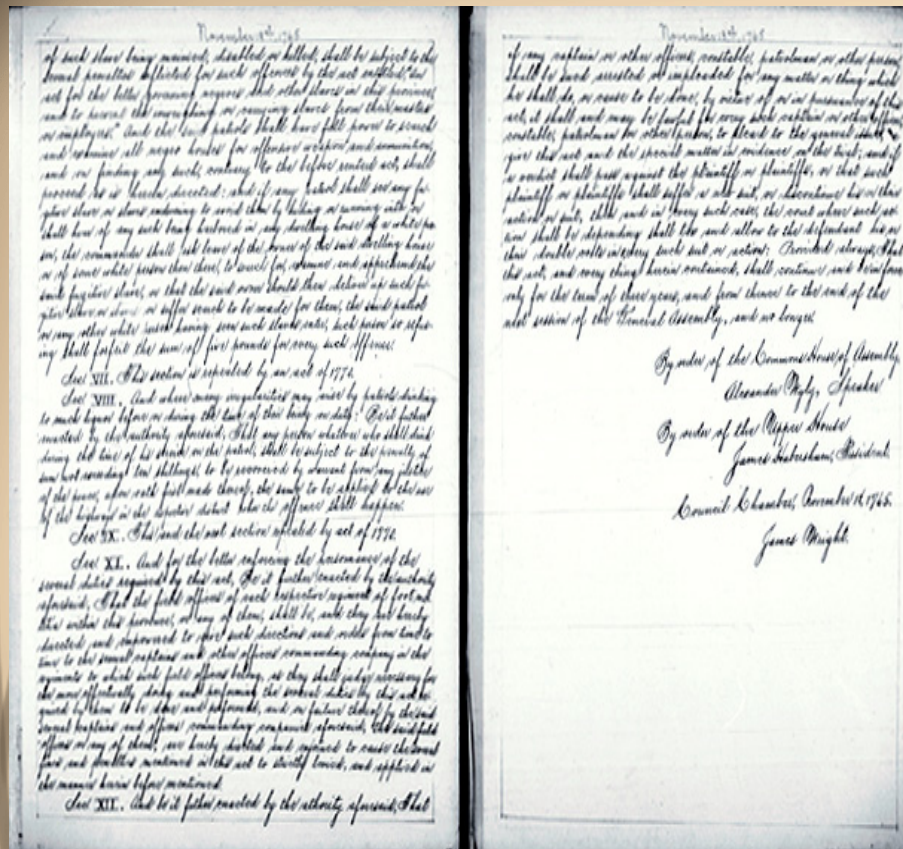
