

**What was Bacon's Rebellion and what was its effect?**

1. Nathaniel Bacon led a group of men in burning Jamestown to show their disapproval of the colony's Indian policy. 2. It marked the turning point from the use of indentured servants to the use of African slave labor.

**What was the Half-way Covenant and what was its purpose?**

1. The Half-way Covenant was a policy of the Puritan church that provided partial church membership for the children of members who did not profess saving grace. 2. It was intended to keep the membership rolls full and maintain the church's influence.
