Participating in "Meatless, Wheatless, Sugarless" days

Committee on Public Information

During the war they were responsible for publicizing the war and for sharing ways citizens could support the war effort

Wilson's Fourteen Points

Wilson's plan for peace after WW I - It was rejected by the European Allies because it was too easy on Germany

Long Term Causes of WW I

1. Militarism
2. Imperialism
3. Nationalism
4. Alliance System

League of Nations

Part of Wilson's Fourteen Points and the Treaty of Versailles - US never joined

British Blockade

strategy used by Britain to keep supplies out of Germany by blocking ships from entering Germany

Lusitania

Ship sunk by the Germans killing many including some Americans

Sedition Act

passed by congress making it illegal to criticize US involvement in WW I

Treaty of Versailles

Signed by the European Allies and Germany - Germany had to disarm, give up territory, say they were solely responsible
