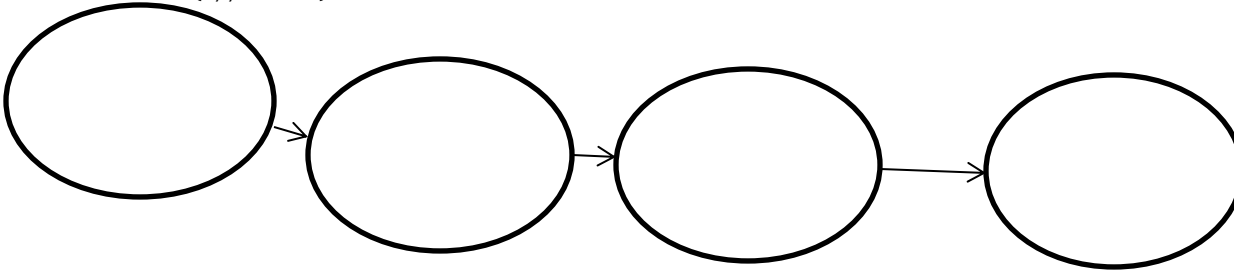


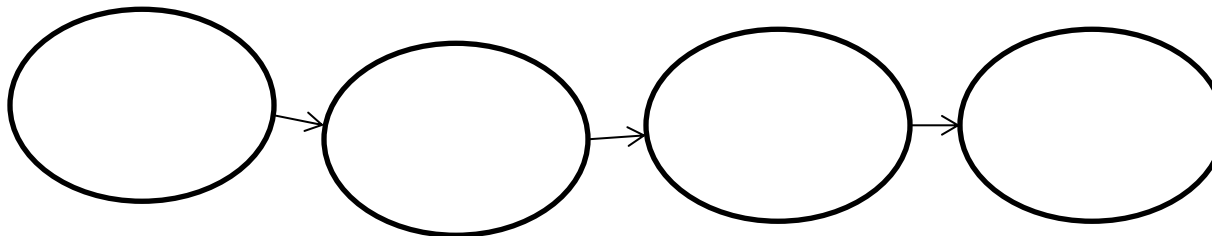

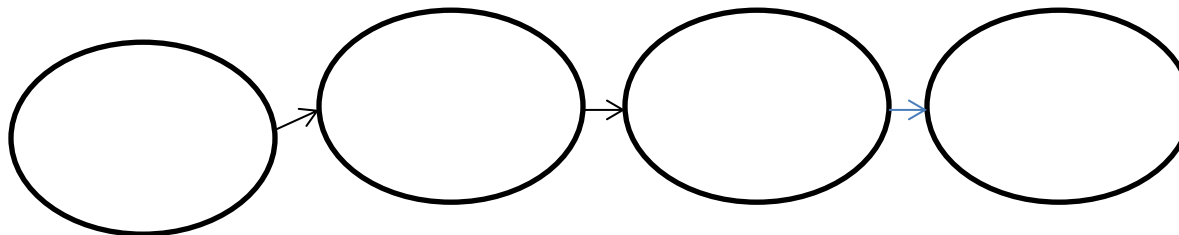
Political Causes (1776-1861)

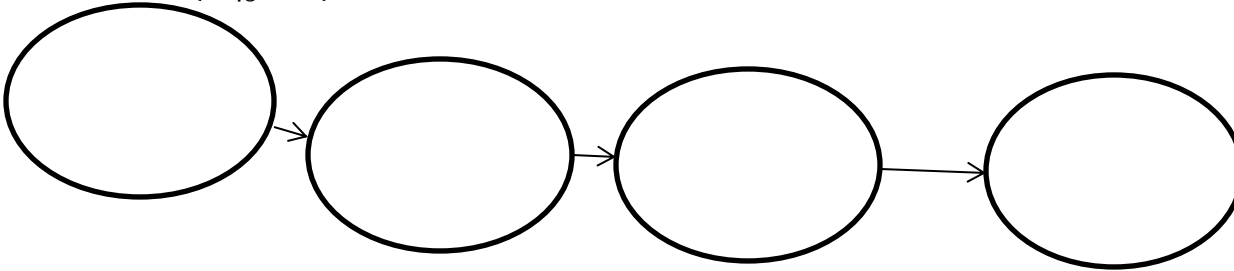

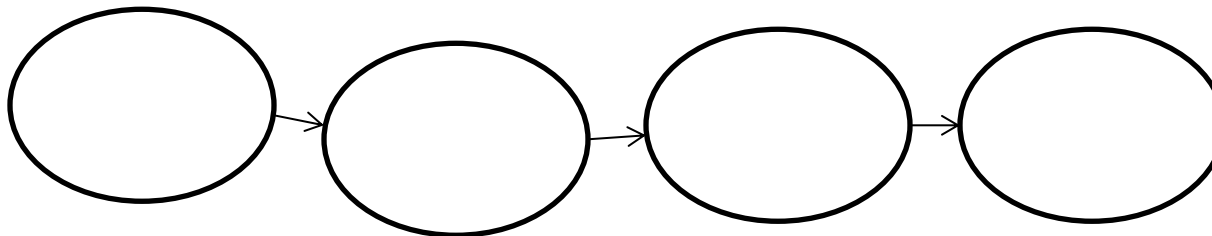

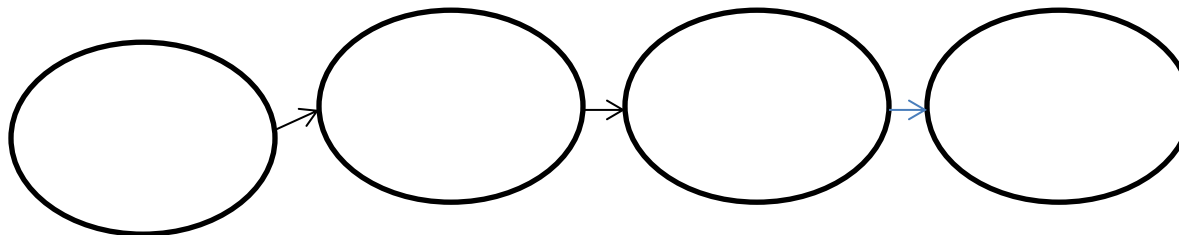
