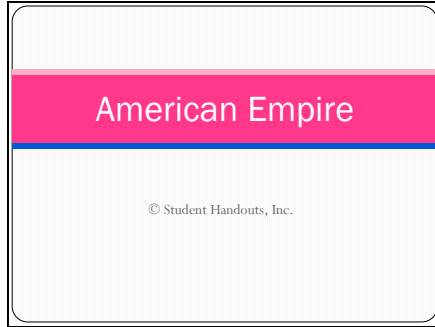

MANIFEST DESTINY

- Idea that United States should expand from Atlantic to Pacific
- Louisiana Purchase (1803-1804)
- Mexican-American War (1846-1848)
- Gadsden Purchase (1853-1854)

"INTERNAL" TERRITORIAL EXPANSION

- **Alaska**
 - "Seward's Folly"
 - Bought from Russia, 1867
 - Became 49th state, 1958
- **Hawaii**
 - Annexed, 1898
 - Became 50th state, 1959
- **Puerto Rico**
 - Acquired following Spanish-American War, 1898
 - Puerto Ricans are American citizens

“EXTERNAL” TERRITORIAL EXPANSION

- **Philippines**
 - Acquired following Spanish-American War, 1898
 - Independent, 1946
- **Samoa, Virgin Islands, Wake, Guam**
 - Acquired by annexation or treaty
 - Military bases
 - Administered by U.S. Department of the Interior
- **Caroline, Mariana, and Marshall Islands**
 - United Nations trusteeships, 1947
 - Military bases
 - Administered by U.S. Department of the Navy
