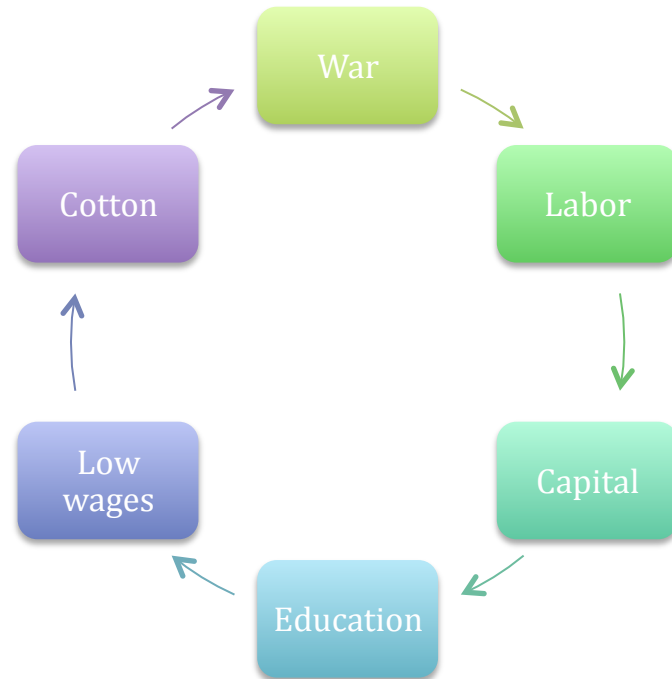


Describe the factors that limited economic recovery in the South after the Civil War.
