

Poster Project

Description:

In a group of 1-2 students, you will create a poster displaying some aspect of the culture and history surrounding German fairy tales.

Requirements:

Your poster should use language and graphics to explain or describe an aspect of German fairy tale history or culture. You can use a cardboard tri-fold for your poster or a standard 24-inch by 36-inch poster board. Your poster should include over 200 words (German).

Production Advice:

You should thoroughly research the cultural or historical topic that you want to share through your poster. After you have written the text you will use on your poster, you will need to get it approved by your teacher before you complete the poster. Always remember that your highest priority in this process is German language production. You want to have good graphics and an interesting historical or cultural topic, but your highest priority is always German language production.
