

Radio Play Project

Description:

In a group of 4-6 students, you will write and produce your own version of a fairy tale in the form of a radio play. You can create a radio play that stays true to the original story, or you can create your own modern version or fractured fairy tale version of the original story.

Requirements:

Your radio play should be about 5 minutes long. You may use sound effects along with dialogue in your radio play. Each member of your group should have a speaking role. Group members may play more than one role in the radio play. The final version of your radio play should be in the MP3 format.

Production Advice:

You should thoroughly plan each scene in your radio play before you write your dialogue. After you have written your dialogue, you will need to get it approved by your teacher before you start recording your sound. You should practice reading your lines out loud multiple times to perfect your pronunciation and intonation before you record your sound. Always remember that your highest priority in this process is German language production. You want to have good acting, fun sound effects, and an entertaining radio play, but your highest priority is always German language production.

Deutscher Tag:

You will have the opportunity to share your radio play with other students at the *Deutscher Tag* on October 9th. Produce a high quality product that you and your group will be proud to share. Bring your radio play on a USB flash drive. You can also look forward to seeing the projects completed by students at other schools.
