

WHO ARE YOU?

The purpose of this assignment is two-fold: it will help me get to know who you are and help you to use the Adobe InDesign tools and skills that we have already learned in class. Your assignment is to create a photo collage of four photos that best describe who you are as a person. You will obtain these photos by searching the Internet and saving the photos to your I:/ drive > Desktop 1 folder > Unit 1 folder. Make sure as you are saving your photos that you cite where your photo came from (see attached worksheet). Once you have found four photos that best describe your life; you will need to create four frame boxes. After your boxes are created you need to “File” then “Place” each image into its respective box. Finally, somewhere on the page create a text box and write 1 paragraph describing the photos relationship to your life. Don't forget to include your name. This assignment is due tomorrow in class and is worth 10 points. The document should be 8.5” w by 11” h, with 0.25” margins. An example of this project is shown below:
