3 SUMMARY PARAGRAPHS OR SECTIONS SHOULD BE AT LEAST 5 SENTENCES PER SECTION AND INCLUDE A TOPIC OR INTRODUCTORY SENTENCE AND A CONCLUDING SENTENCE. EACH SECTION SHOULD BE CENTERED AROUND ONE OF THE KINDS OF TEXT CONNECTIONS.

YOU MUST INCLUDE: **TITLE OF ARTICLE: NAME OF PUBLICATION WHERE IT WAS FOUND (IE WHICH NEWSPAPER, MAGAZINE, INTERNET SITE, ETC); DATE OF PUBLICATION: PLACE WHERE EVENT TOOK PLACE**
