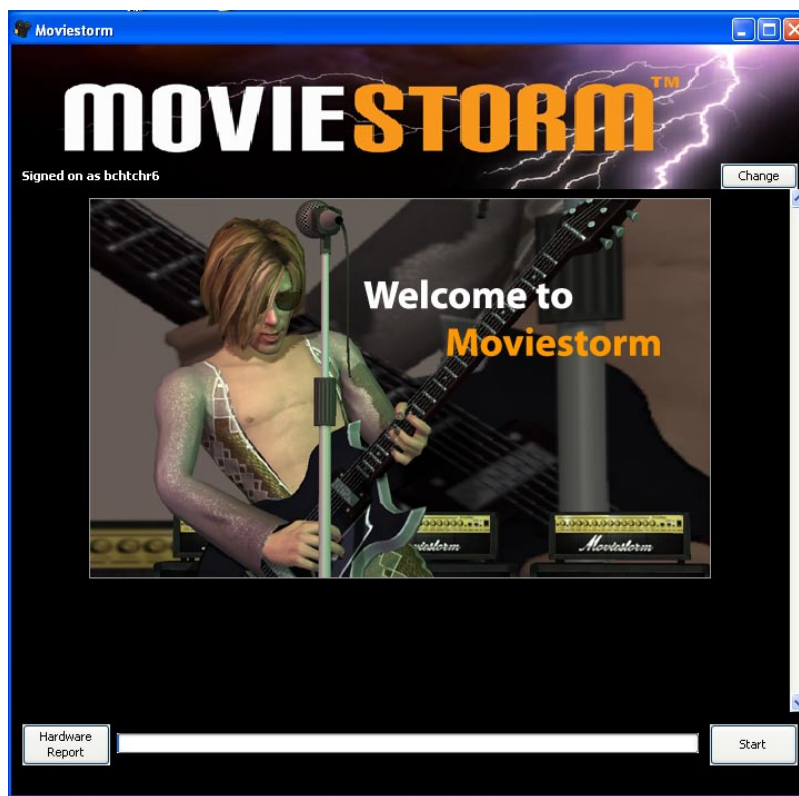


A QUICK TUTORIAL FOR CREATING A STUDENT PROJECT USING MOVIESTORM™

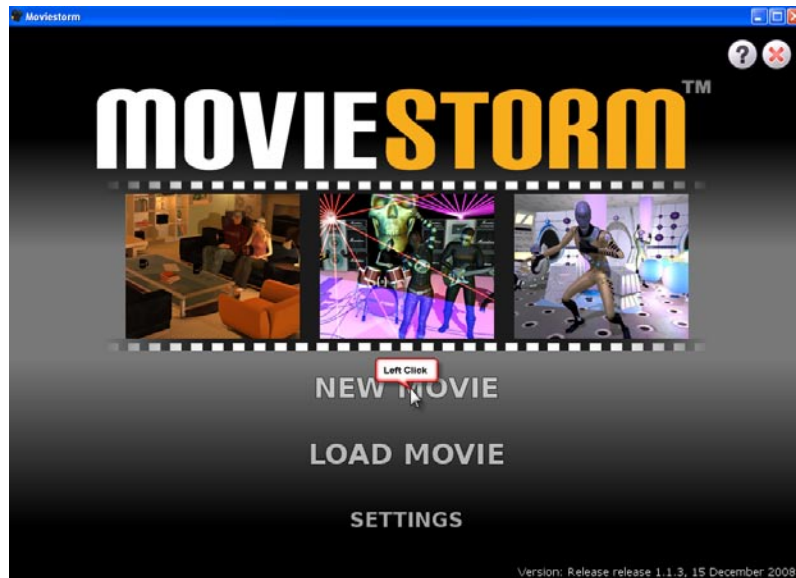
This is a quick project that can be accomplished in a classroom in around 30 minutes. The project will take a student written assignment and allow them to create an animation of the project being read. Any writing assignment can be used for this project. This is designed as an introductory project. This project uses the Moviestorm™ quick start wizard.

This tutorial is designed to give step by step directions and not a lot of extra narrative. By reading the extra information provided on the wizard screens you will gain further insight to the process which will allow you to make modifications to your movie.

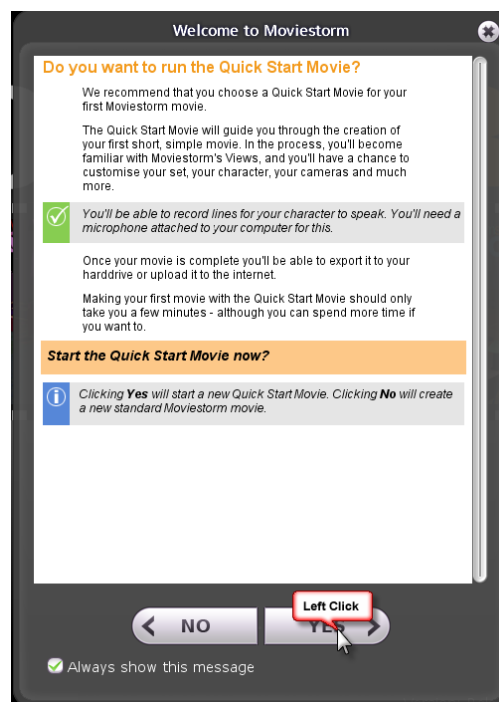
1. Locate the Moviestorm™ icon on your desktop or in your main menu and click it to start the program. As the program starts you will be presented with the Welcome screen.



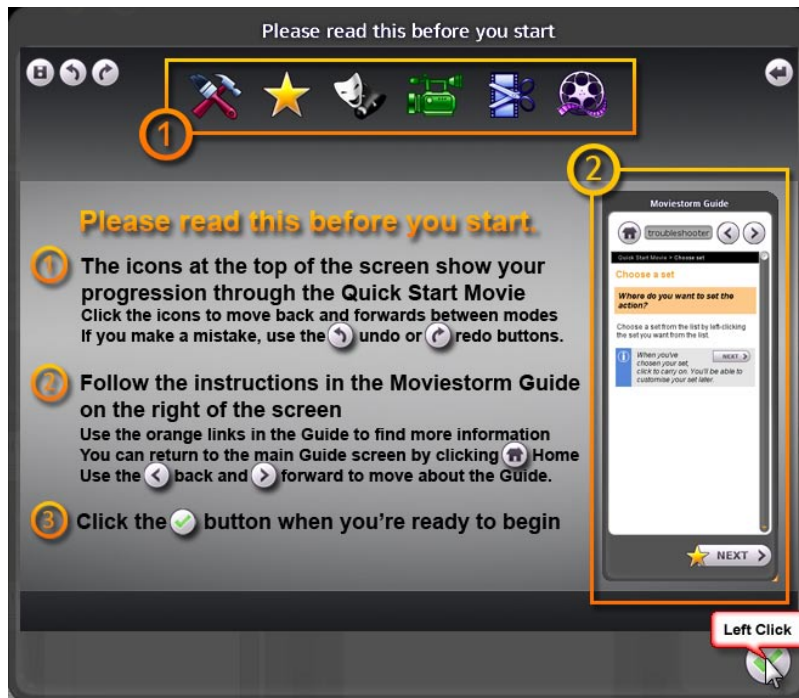
2. On the welcome screen, click start.



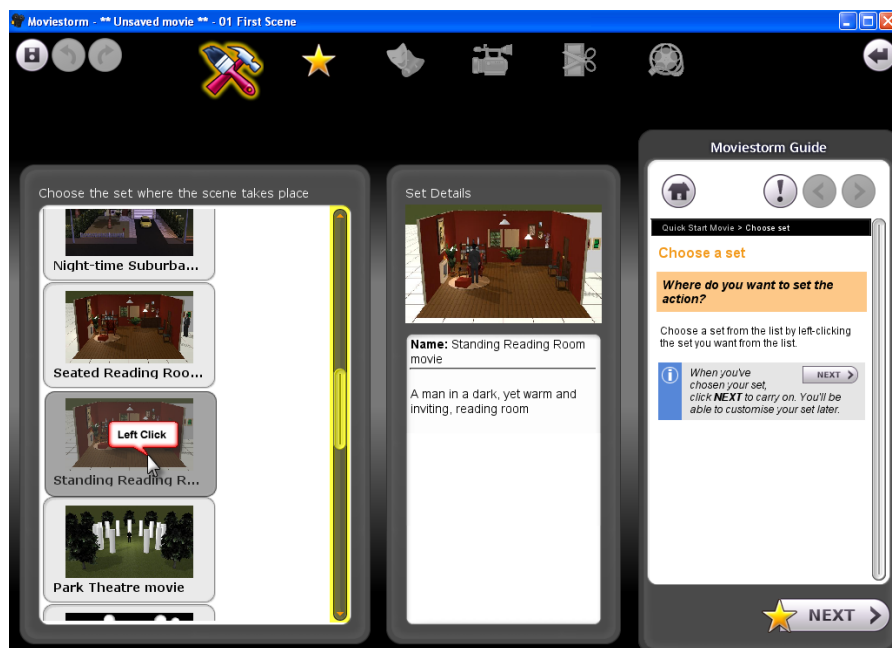
3. On the menu screen click “New Movie”.



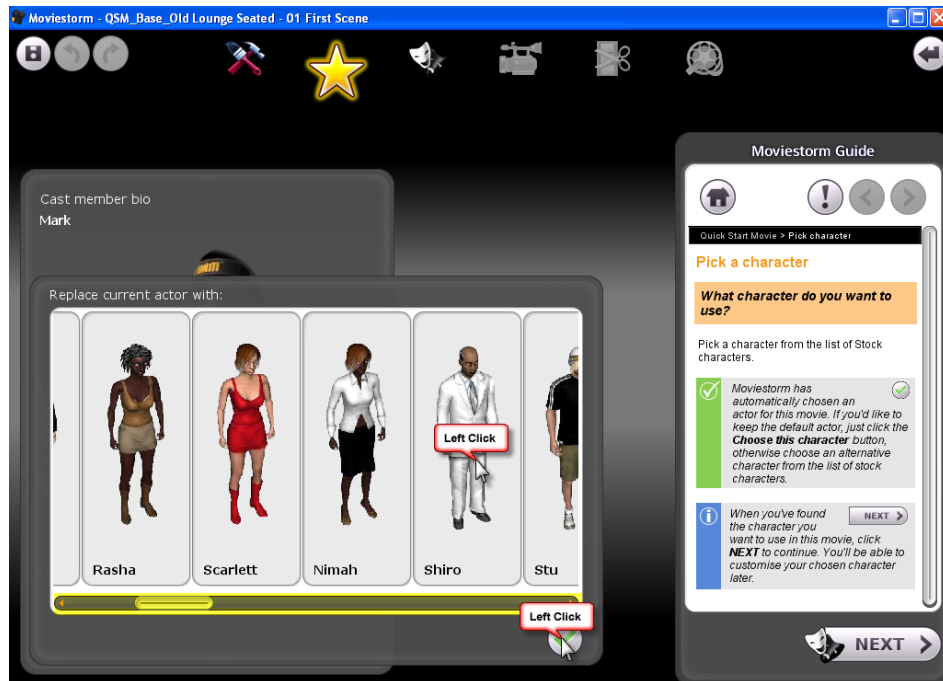
4. On the Quick Start Movie screen, read the instructions then click “YES”.



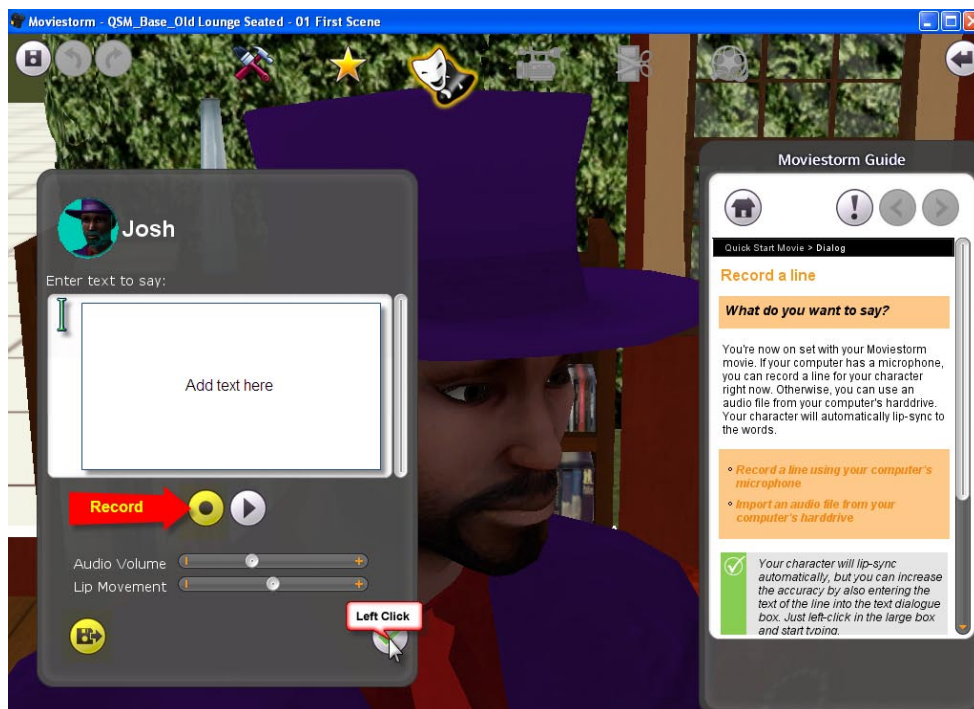
5. On the Read this before you start screen, read the instructions and click the check mark.



6. On the “Where do you want to set the action?” screen, use the scroll bar to scroll through the list of possible sets until you see “Standing Reading Room”. Select this scene by clicking on it and then click “Next”.

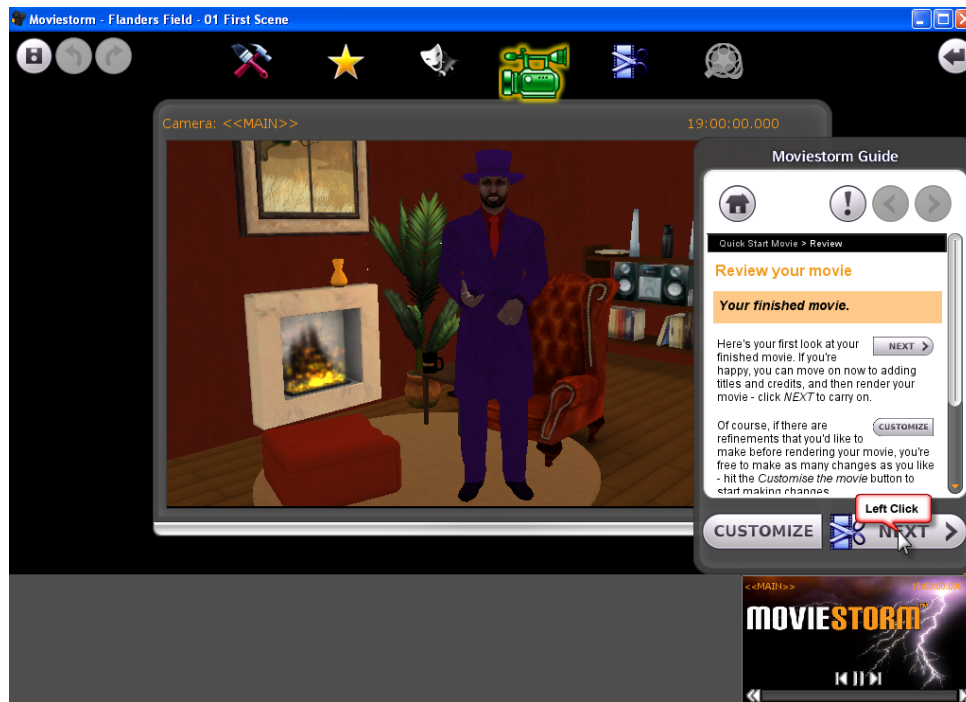


7. On the “What character do you want to use” screen, use the scroll bar to scroll through the possible actors for your animation. Click on the actor you wish to select and then click “Next”.

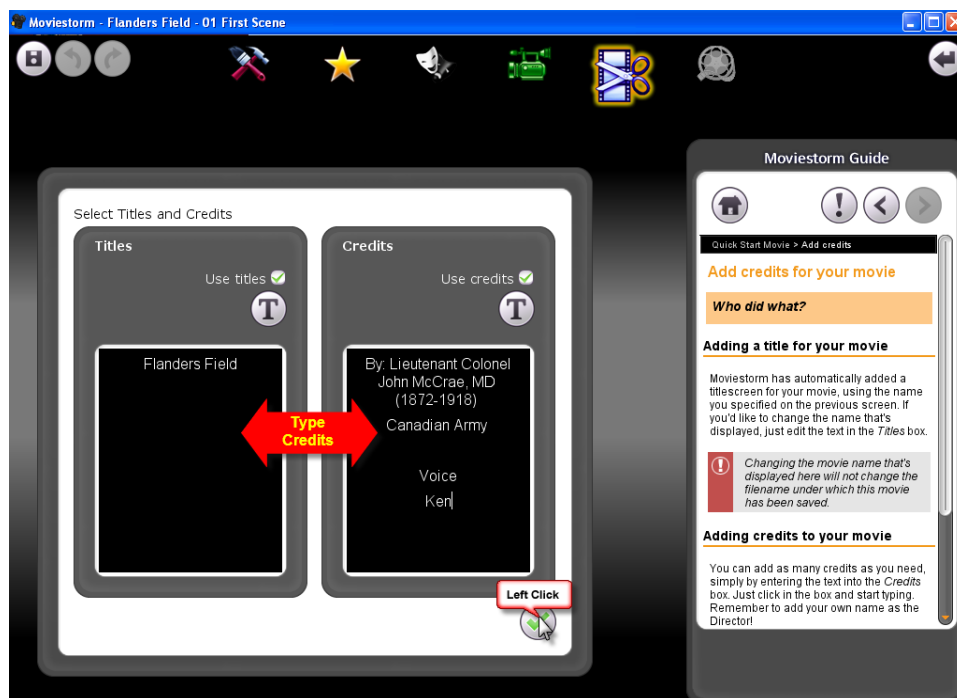


8. On the “What do you want to say?” screen, type the text your actor will say in the text box. You can either use the record button to record your spoken voice or

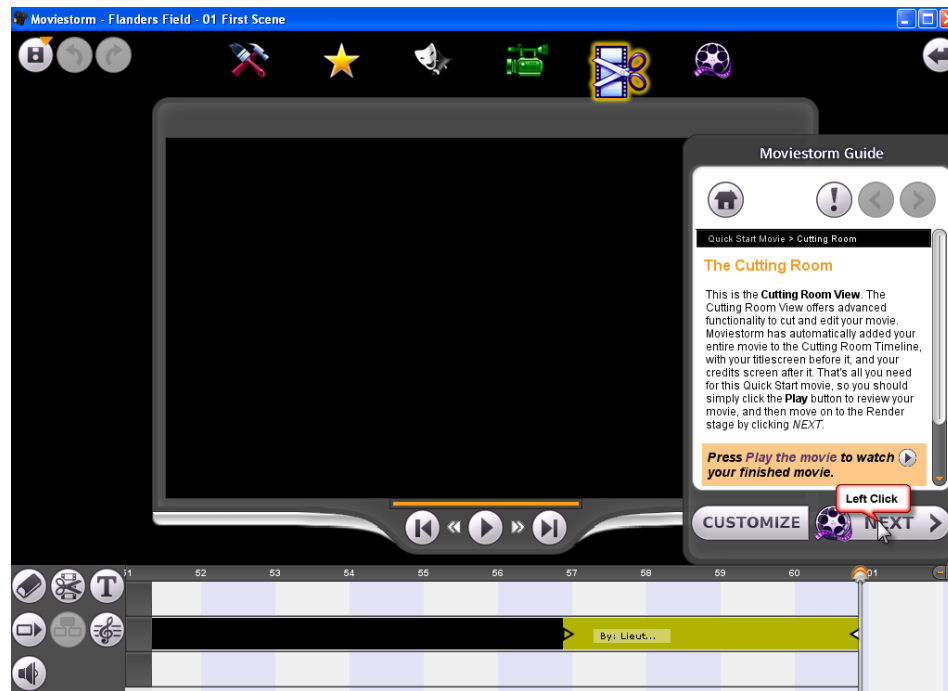
import an audio file by clicking on the disk in the left corner. Once you have entered your text and audio narration, click “Next”.



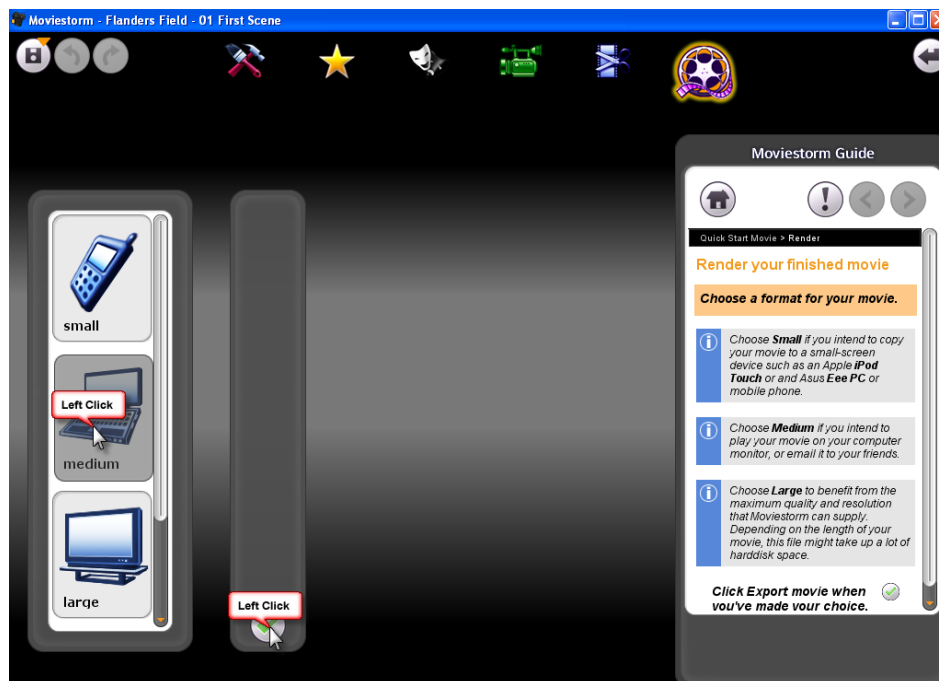
9. On the “Your finished movie.” Screen, your movie will automatically play. When it is has completed, click “Next”



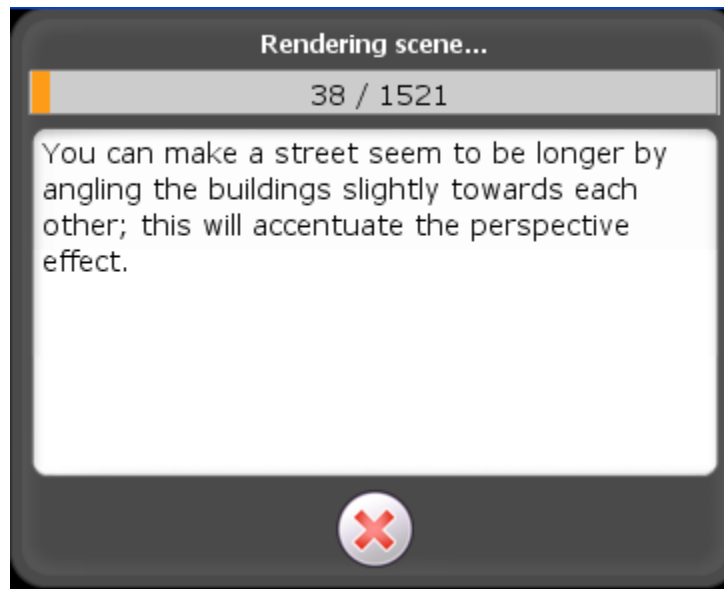
10. On the “Who did what?” screen enter any information for titles that will play at the beginning of the movie or credits that will play at the end of the movie.



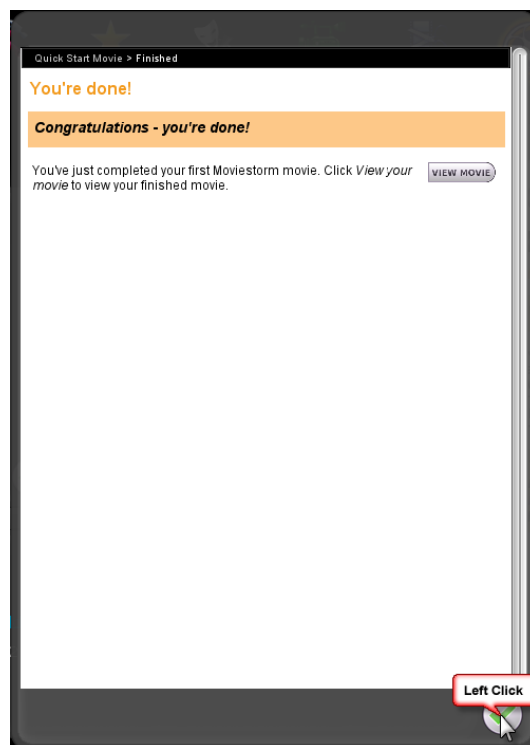
11. On “The Cutting Room” screen click “Next”.



12. On the “Render your finished movie” screen, click medium and then click the check mark. Your movie will now render. You will see each screen appear as your movie is completed.



13. On the “You’re done!” screen click the check mark.



14. On the “You’re done!” screen click “View movie” to see your creation.
