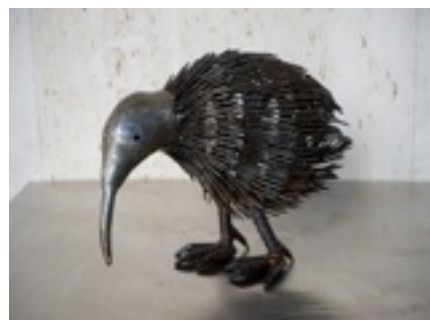
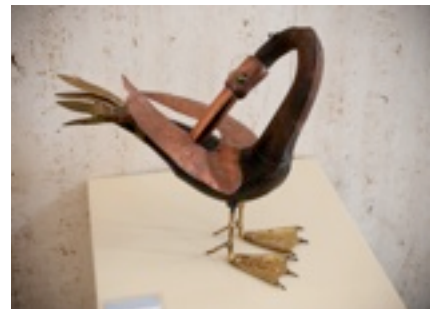

Cash Prizes for Students and their School Participation Certificates for all entrants Public Exhibition Opportunities

Criteria

- Predominately metal construction containing some sheetmetal (Contact the SIA for assistance if required or approach local sheetmetal businesses for off cuts)
- Work of one student only per sculpture
- Open to students of 2011/2012
- Less than 1m x 1m x 1m
- 20kg maximum weight
- Free standing or displayable on SIA plinth (must be non-hanging)
- Able to withstand occasional touching and not fall over or break
- Dangerous designs to be encased with safety aspects considered
- Must be publicly acceptable and in good taste
- Costs associated with transportation of sculptures to be met by nominee/school

Entry Information

- Multiple entries permitted from the same school/class
- Email sculpture photos with completed nomination form and artist statement by Thursday 5th April 2012 to events@sheetmetalaustralia.com.au

Judging Process

Round One: A panel of industry judges select 10 sculptures from the photos submitted by nominees. The sculptors name, age and school remain anonymous for this process. Each finalist receives complimentary tickets to the prestigious Sydney based Sculpture Launch and Gala Dinner and is invited to submit their sculpture for display in the Art of Sheetmetal Exhibitions.

Round Two: Following the Sculpture Launch, a panel of judges including prominent industry members and established artists select the award winning sculptures from the exhibition to be announced at the Industry Gala Dinner.
