- Log onto myfuture.edu.au
- Go to **My Profile** Section of website – Join (Create new account).
- Ensure sound is turned on.
- Complete My Profile – Using the picture option complete Interests - education & training and skills sections only.
- Go to My Profile Summary. Look at options that have come up with limited information.
- Parent task – Consider what occupation you have now and the profile. Do they match? Is it different to what you thought you may be doing at the age of 15? Put yourself in your child's shoes. Expand your thinking for your child.
- Go to **The Facts**. Scroll through all the headings. Each leads to different areas of the site. Tonight we will look at Courses and Programs.
- Using the search facility, type in medical careers. Thousands of options come up. Now use filters to refine the search. Go back and enter a filter eg location of study.
- There is also a search facility at the top of the screen in The Facts section. (demonstrate or explore)
