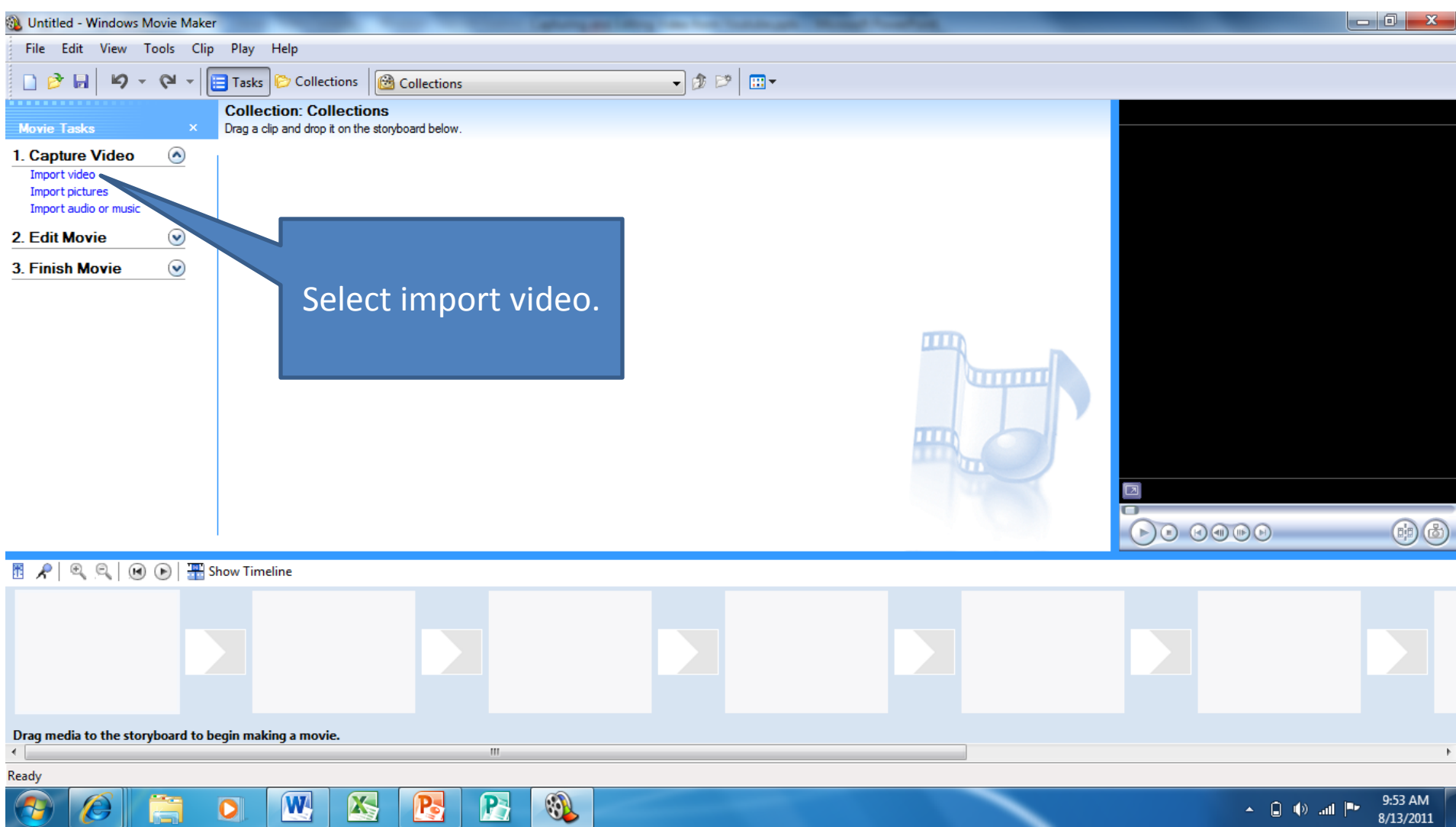


Part III – Importing, editing, and adding prompts in Windows Movie Maker.



Go to your programs menu and select Windows Movie Maker 2.6

Import your video.



Select all the clips and drag them to your storyboard.
