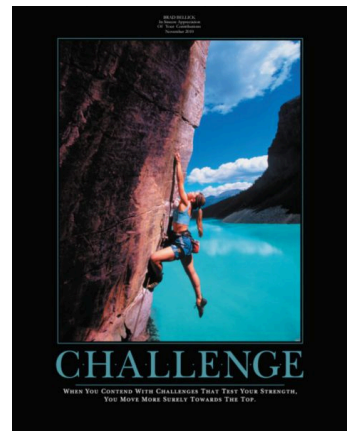


Motivational Poster for Cerebral Palsy Awareness



Your assignment today is to create a “Motivational Style” poster for Cerebral Palsy Awareness, here at McKinley as a closing to our one book, one school read of “Out of My Mind”

1. View some examples of motivational posters at ...
2. Open a New Blank Document in MS Word and save it as CP Aware Poster.
Find a picture online that would inspire awareness and open-mindedness towards people with cerebral palsy or other disabilities. To ensure that you are not breaking copyright laws, please go to www.creativecommons.org
3. Download or copy the image to your desktop and then use the insert menu to insert the picture into your MS Word document

Hint: if you want a picture on creative commons that comes from Flickr, you need to on Actions - view the picture and then choose to download it

4. Insert a large rectangle to cover the majority of the page in black

Hint: From the Toolbox, click on the object palette tab at the top left hand corner, and insert a rectangle. Click on the rectangle and from the Toolbox, Select the Color, Weights and Fill menu and change the fill color to black

5. Put a white border around the picture

Hint: click on the picture, then open the Toolbox and you will be able to use Quick Styles and Effects

6. Format the picture's layout so that it is behind the text

Hint: click on the picture, then the format menu -> picture. Select the layout option and choose to Wrapping Style – Behind Text

7. Add an inspirational quote

Hint: go to the website http://www.finestquotes.com/select_quote-category-Disability-page-0.htm
