

2D Art Photo – Subjects

Throughout the course of this semester and year, you will be creating a variety of projects showcasing different techniques and skills. To allow for more creativity and individualism students will be required to take your own photos to use as subjects for your art-work. You should have a min. of 25 photos to showcase from the following categories:

PHOTOS – Min.

- 4 self-portraits (try creative and unique shots and views)
- 2 portraits of inspiring person or persons
- 2 prized possessions – something of value to you
- 2 favorite activities / hobbies
- 4 nature subjects – plants/ animals
- 2 fruit / veggie subjects
- 2 something reflective in nature (light-bulbs, glass objects, mirrors, chrome, sunglasses, t.v., etc.)
- 7 a strong subject exploring each element of art: LINE, SHAPE, VALUE, COLOR, TEXTURE, SPACE, FORM.

*Make sure all images are of good taste and appropriate for k-12 setting and something that is interesting for you to use as a subject. Also pay close attention to background and other pieces that might be within the picture. If you don't want to have to draw it... plan accordingly! If you would like a challenging subject, find something with a lot of unique textures for several photo options.
