

Senior Display

For 4th quarter, instead of a third project you will create a display of your work that you have done during your high school career as well as writing an essay reflecting your art experience. All together it will be worth 100pts.

Requirements for an A for the Senior Display are as follows:

- Design a CREATIVE name Marquee including your name, grade, and current class you are taking. (Adv. Art I or II)
- Choose a minimum of 8 of your best pieces to display. Be creative in displaying your work in the display case. You may use other things in your display for “character,” such as material to hang in the background, flowers, items that describe who you are or where you are going in life, etc. Just keep things all in good taste and k-12 appropriate.
- Create Title cards to go with each piece. Include a title or write untitled along with what media you used.
- All the preparation for this should take a minimum of a week. (may include 1 class period to set-up and 1 class period to take down)

Requirements for an A for the Essay are as follows:

- Respond to the following ideas relating to the past 4 years:
- What art classes have you taken and what do you feel you have gotten out of them, or how have they helped to sculpt who you are as an artist currently.
 - How have you changed or developed as an artist as well as a person?
 - What do you see in your future artistically; do you plan on going to school for art, taking any art classes for fun, or do you see yourself creating any art on your own once high school is done?
 - Talk about one or many of your favorite artist or artists; do you think they have had any influence in what you do?
 - What has been some of your favorite projects that you have created?
- Min. 2 pages typed, double spaced, No more than 1 inch margins top, bottom, and sides, Times New Roman Font no larger than 14.
