Project Information Sheet

Assignment: choose one of the following ideas for this project:

- 1.) Repeat a popular image of your choice of American Culture.
(ex. Crest toothpaste, Dial soap, Doritos chips, Dr. Pepper cans, etc.)
- 2.) Roy Lichtenstein Band-Aid dot technique over top any pop art image.
- 3.) Comic Strip
 - ✓ One to three frames long
 - ✓ Subject of your choice
- 4.) Design your own label for a container. Include product information:
 - ✓ Bold, creative, and eye catching top and side labels with graphics
 - ✓ Brand name
 - ✓ Nutritional facts and ingredients
 - ✓ Bar code
 - ✓ Glue label to product container for a finished look
- 5.) Thiebaud Food repeating (cake, pie, ice cream, etc.)
 - ✓ Sketch an image of your favorite food dish outside of class and bring it back for ideas for your final drawing.
 - ✓ Draw either 1 close up view of a food dish or repeat the same image multiple times.

Criteria for all drawings:

- 1.) Fill out the worksheet in regards to what idea you are going to choose and create a preliminary sketch before beginning your final project.
- 2.) Use flat colors, heavy black lines (outlining), simple shapes / objects that tie it to the Pop art theme.
- 3.) You may choose whether you would like to work with markers, colored pencils, crayons, or china markers, on thick cardstock paper.
- 4.) Creatively use all of your space within the picture plane including the

background. Paper is not a color.
