

Posterize Yourself – Tempera Painting



Tempera Paint



- ✦ A paint and process involving an emulsion of oil and water. It was in use before the invention of oil paints. Traditionally it involves an egg emulsion; thus the term egg tempera. The pigments or colors are mixed with an emulsion of egg yolks rather than oil, and can be thinned with water.

Learning Targets / Competencies:

- ✦ The artist created a posterized tempera painting, self-portrait utilizing picmonkey.com (posterize filter) on a self-portrait picture.
- ✦ The artist demonstrated knowledge of accurately representing the subject using tempera paint, and the style of posterizing incorporating a min. of 8 different colors or values.
- ✦ The artist used the space (min. 14 x 16 size) within the picture plane effectively / creatively. (Not a lot of open space).
- ✦ Overall Good Craftsmanship was evident as this was a well-put together painting having pencil lines erased or painted over. All areas of the paper were painted.
- ✦ Reflection: The artist critiqued their final projects on their blog including all reflection pieces and a photo of their art. (Explain what you created, what materials you used, what you learned, strengths, and areas for improvement).
