

# Value Scale Drawing

## *Assignment Criteria:*

- 1.) Complete the value scale practice handout in regards to using three techniques; line, hatching, and pointillism. This is to be turned in before you begin your final drawing.
- 2.) Choose one of the three techniques learned as well as a gray scale drawing subject (meaning a black and white subject with also a lot of gray values to it as well). This can be a 3D object / image you bring in or a photo you have on your computer. You may want to upload in picnic and alter so it is easier to see value differences.
- 3.) Plan ahead: Figure out how to use your space creatively and sketch out the main shapes of your subject lightly with a pencil, because ink doesn't erase well.
- 4.) Demonstrate that you understand the idea of creating a wide range of values (4-5 different values) within your subject of choice by using lines, hatching, or, pointillism with 1 color of ink.
