

2D and 3D Student Blogs

Throughout the course of the year, you will be required to create a blog in regards to your artwork and growth throughout the year as an artist. After every project, you are responsible for updating your blog with your artwork, critiquing your artwork. We will then share your blog with the class each semester. The purpose of blogging in art is to meet all National Art Content Standards as well as have a common place to showcase your work and discuss your art.

Netiquette: When blogging either on your own blog or commenting on others, make sure to use appropriate netiquette. Remember you are a part of online community of learners. The students you are collaborating with are real, and therefore, you must remember to interact with them in a respectful manner. Posted material should be appropriate and for all age levels to read. Please write clearly and avoid "text" language as well. For safety purposes please do not post personal information about where you live and or what you are doing, keep it basic.

Quarter 1 Requirements:

- Creation of the Blog:
 - Create a blog using blogger.com
 - Choose a template, colors, widgets to add, etc.
 - Add a photo – either of you or something relating to you such as a graphic or word cloud.
 - Add a biography about you as an artist – keep it simple not too much personal information.
 - Add your blog site to Mrs. Comer's google doc.
- Upload each project you have created during quarter 1 along with a short description of what the piece is.
- Critique each project during the course of the quarter answering the "Critique Questions" at the bottom of this handout.

Quarter 2 Requirements:

- Upload each project you have created during quarter 2 along with a short description of what the piece is.

- Critique each project during the course of the quarter answering the “Critique Questions” at the bottom of this handout.
- Semester Critique and share your blog (part of your Semester Test Grade)

Quarter 3 Requirements:

- Upload each project you have created during quarter 3 along with a short description of what the piece is.
- Critique each project during the course of the quarter answering the “Critique Questions” at the bottom of this handout.

Quarter 4 Requirements:

- Upload each project you have created during quarter 4 along with a short description of what the piece is.
- Critique each project during the course of the quarter answering the “Critique Questions” at the bottom of this handout.
- Semester Critique and share your blog (part of your Semester Test Grade)

***CRITIQUE QUESTIONS:**

Upon completion of each project upload a photo to your blog and write a reflection in regards to the following topics. For full credit discuss each piece in detail (a couple sentences rather than a couple words).

- Explain what you created and what media you used in this process.
- What did you learn?
- What are you most proud of?
- What are you least proud of?
