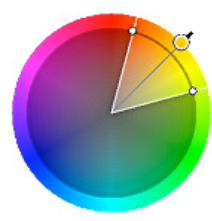


Color Scheme Painting

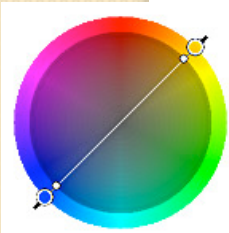
- For the next Painting assignment choose a color scheme or two from the following list of 6, and create a painting in reference to it.

Color Schemes

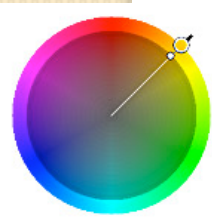


Analogous Colors: Colors next to each other on the color wheel.

(ex. red-orange, orange, yellow-orange)



Complimentary Colors: Colors across from each other on the color wheel. (opposites) (ex. red and green)



Monochromatic Colors: 1 color with blacks and whites added to it. (lights or darks of 1 color or gradience of 1 color) (mono- meaning 1 and chromatic meaning presence of color.)

Achromatic Color Scheme: A colorless scheme using blacks, whites, and grays.



Warm Color Scheme: Aggressive colors such as reds, oranges, and yellows.



Cool Color Scheme: Receding colors such as greens, blues, and violets.
