

Slab Vessel

Slabs are sheets or slices of clay that are rolled out, often with a rolling pin, to a desired thickness and wrapped, folded, or cut and joined together. Although it is easier to do a box form, there are many other possibilities as well. What other shapes could you join together? Keep in mind that some of the most interesting pieces of art are different and unusual.

For this assignment you are to construct some kind of slab vessel. Meaning a container for holding something. (ex. vase, pitcher, tea pot, vessel for change, a plant, etc.)

Requirements:

- Join a minimum of 3 slabs together to create your form.
- Minimum size about 8 inches tall.
- You must incorporate texture somehow in this piece.
(what kinds of interesting textures can you add or create to the surface?)
- **BE CREATIVE!!!! And TAKE YOUR TIME**

Keep in mind that you will be graded on craftsmanship, creativity, effort, time on task as well as following these requirements.
