Summary This excerpt from Edwards's sermon describes God's rising anger against the sinners in the congregation. These sinners, Edwards says, are like spiders that their angry God holds over hell. Edwards tells his listeners that they can save their souls from everlasting suffering only if they beg God for forgiveness now and experience the saving grace of conversion, which will give them a place among the elect, or those chosen by God.
