<p>Discussion Director: Ask Questions</p>	<p>For example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How well can I identify with these characters and situations? • What seems likely to happen next? • What events seem likely? unlikely? <p>YOUR IDEAS:</p>
<p>Literary Luminary: Look for the Best Parts</p>	<p>For example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identify a section, a piece of dialogue, or an event that really struck you; tell why. • Figure out how to get the group to appreciate this part. <p>YOUR IDEAS:</p>
<p>Connector: Connect Ideas</p>	<p>For example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Connect to things you have experienced at home, at school, or in your personal life. • Connect to what is going on in the world right now. <p>YOUR IDEAS:</p>
<p>Illustrator: Put Ideas into Pictures</p>	<p>For example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Draw a picture of an important event or character. • Draw a diagram that shows how you reacted to something in the book. <p>YOUR IDEAS:</p>
