Grades: Grades in this course will be evaluated according to this weighted system:

Tests/Quizzes	30%
Classwork	25%
Homework	10%
Labs	25%
Participation	10%

Late/missing work: The student is responsible for completing all course assignments, including assignments missed on days absent. Students will have 1 week to complete make-up assignments. Should the absence be unexcused, late work will be given 75% credit.

Any late work not submitted within 1 week will not be accepted.

Make-up tests/quizzes & labs: Make-ups should be arranged with the teacher. The only time for make-ups will be after school. The student is responsible for finding a time & date within 1 week of the test/quiz.

Retakes on tests/quizzes: Any student that wishes to retake a test or a quiz will have 1 opportunity to do so. The retake must be done within 1 week of the test/quiz. Students are permitted to make changes to any missed questions on the original test/quiz. Of the corrections on the missed questions, students receive 25% credit on the corrections.

Discipline: Minor infractions will be sent as an FYI to the administration of GCHS. Major infractions will warrant a referral to the office and removal from class.

Finals policy: Everyone takes the final.
