Technical Support

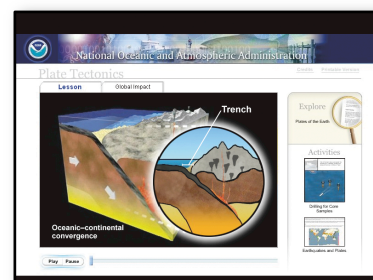
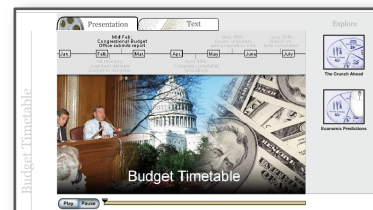
Installation help and technical support are available, along with access to documentation, FAQs, and regular course updates.
