- ✓ Learn a new craft- make beads, construct a model plane from balsa – ask for help
- ✓ Offer to help in the garden- learn some new plant names
- ✓ Make a set of noughts and crosses out of twigs and stones- challenge your friends & family
- ✓ Collect jokes- make a booklet of the best ones
- ✓ Learn a new song or an old one from your grandparents
- ✓ Learn to sew on a button- then make a card, a picture etc
- ✓ Google 'How to make a pompom' ask first- what can you make with them?
- ✓ Collect shells, hang them on a string outside, make a necklace or a wrist band- teach a friend
- ✓ Cover an old empty tin with fabric, paper, paint and then give as a gift filled with flowers
- ✓ Make a flower Mandela using petals and a puddle of water- ask before picking flowers
- ✓ Google 'How to make a spinning top'- challenge your friends – who's can spin the longest?
- ✓ Find a book or Google origami ideas- make some cool containers or animals using paper
- ✓ Grow your name in seeds- ask for help
- ✓ Get a book of 'science experiments' from the library- get help and take photos of what you do
- ✓ Use old Christmas cards to decorate boxes or containers- organise your room
- ✓ Email friends and family- share some of your jokes
- ✓ Make a kite- be careful where you fly it
- ✓ Watch a DVD with the English subtitles turned on
- ✓ Decorate a flower pot and ask for some plants to grow- marigolds are great
- ✓ Find a new recipe and ask if you can cook with someone- give some away
- ✓ Use old card board boxes- make a garage or a house for younger brothers/ sisters
- ✓ Paint a picture- sketch a bird on the lawn or take photos and write captions
- ✓ Make a power point about your holiday
- ✓ Learn to create a 'photo story' – free to download- ask first!
- ✓ Teach grandparents a game you enjoy- x box etc
- ✓ Play card games- keep the score
- ✓ Make skittles using empty lemonade/ coke bottles- paint them and then play a game
- ✓ Decorate a T- shirt- ask first- put on your name, a picture or some words
- ✓ Make an obstacle course around your back yard. Time yourself to see how fast you can go
- ✓ Learn to play knuckle bones- teach someone else
- ✓ Read a book up in a tree, in a hut, on a log - RELAX but wear sunscreen
- ✓ Find as many words as you can on a cereal packet- make a list- ask for help if you get stuck
