TUITION ASSISTANCE (Things to Know):

- Everyone is encouraged to apply- if you think you may need assistance you should apply.
- Deadlines are VERY important- apply on time to ensure you are considered.
- For the 2011-2012 school year 1.4 million dollars in tuition assistance was awarded to families at Moreau Catholic High School.
- The average tuition assistance grant reduces tuition by 36%.
- Tuition assistance can be combined with Merit Based Scholarships and FACE.

DEADLINE: MARCH 1, 2012 | FEE: \$24

- 4. Apply for tuition assistance**
- 5. Attend the Student-Parent Interview|** Office of Admission will email you the date and time
- 6. Additional requirements for specific applicants will be communicated via email after the completion of the application**
