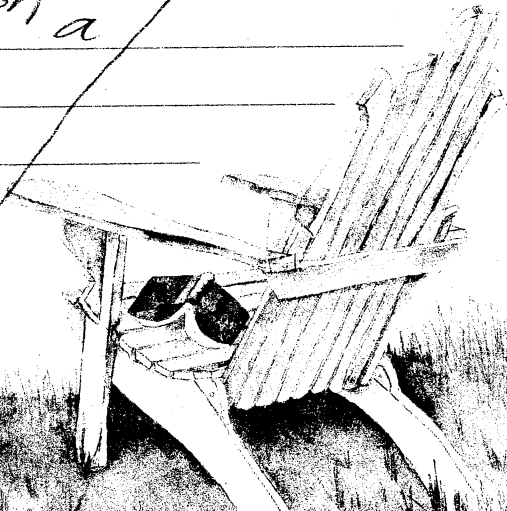

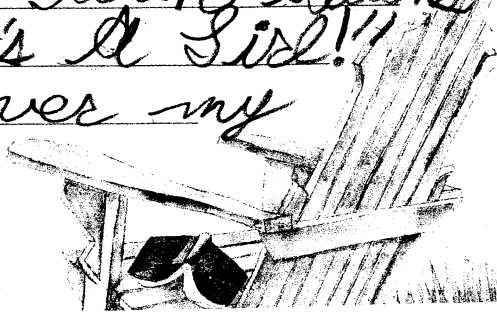

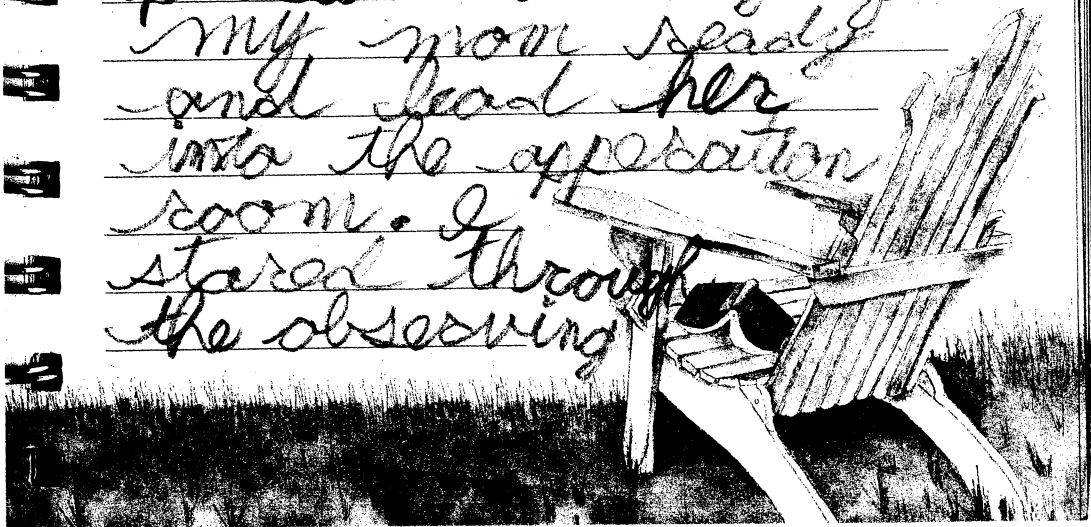
On January 28, 1999,
