

MONEY SCOOT



Directions:

1. Cut out the money cards and distribute one to each student. Kiddos must make that amount of money and leave it on his/her desk. They need to hide their card inside their desk. Use a dry erase marker to number each child's desk.
2. Once everyone has created their coin amounts, they take their paper and "scoot" to another child's desk to count the money and record it in the correct box on their paper.
3. Continue to do this until everyone has visited each desk and kiddos have made it back to their own seat. You can time each "scoot" or you can wait until most kiddos finish.
4. Have each kiddo read his/her number and amount so that everyone can check.
