

Highlights of Changes in 2.0.13.131

Access Right Control for View Flow

There are some new access rights records added. These access rights are to control user access to the **“View Flow”** function at Sales and Purchase transactions. To access these access rights, user can go to **Menu → General Maintenance → Access Right Maintenance → Under AutoCount Accounting → Invoicing → Sales or Purchase → Transaction (Quotation, Sales Order etc) → Can View Flow** (Refer Figure 1).

Restructure Search Lookup Edit

The **search lookup** in AutoCount Accounting 2.0 had been **restructured**. Starting from this version, the option to **“Apply Search by LINQ in Search Lookup Editor”** had been removed. For now, the search lookup editor **will always apply LINQ technology in its searching** and there is **performance improvement in terms of loading** any screens that has search lookup.

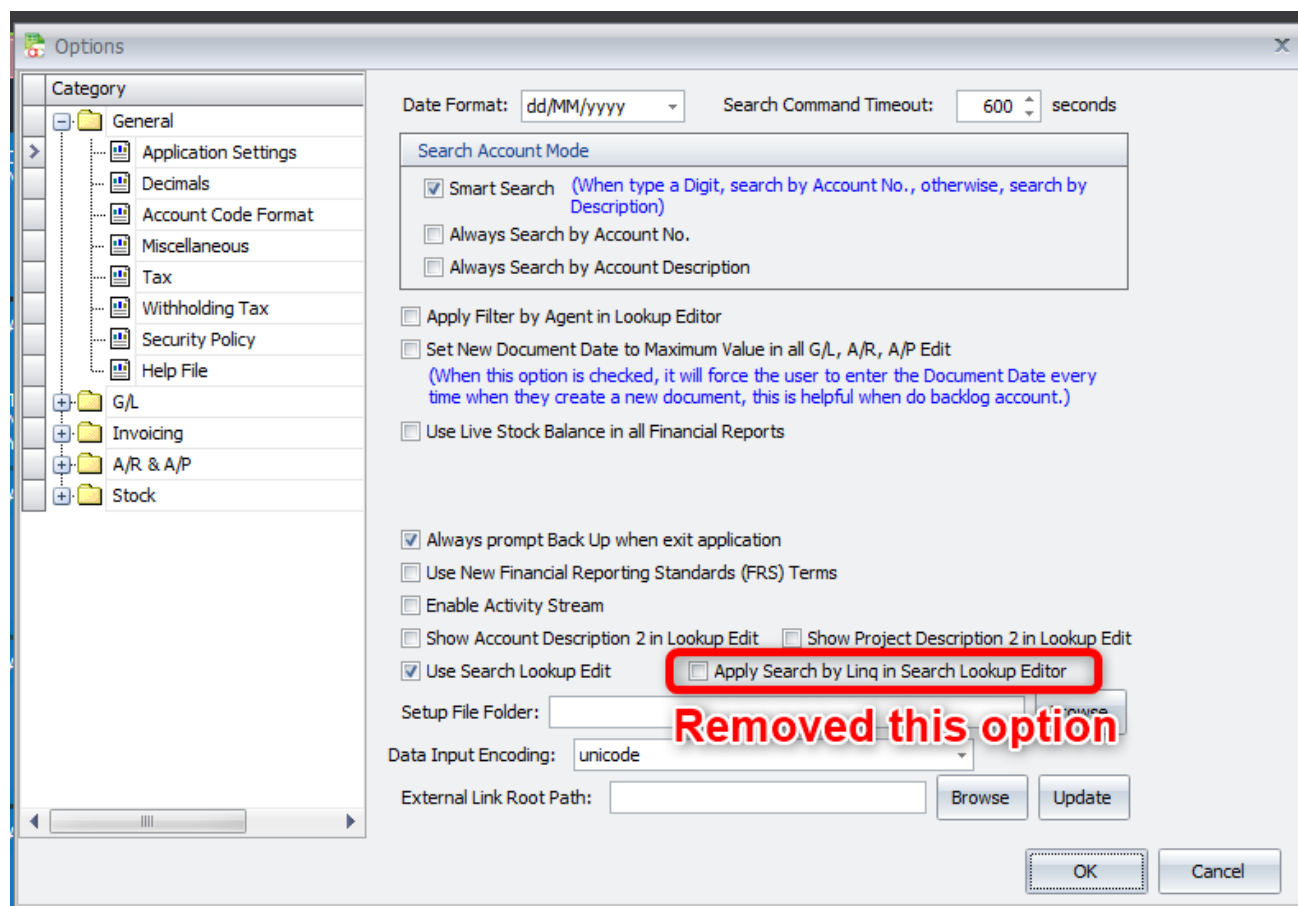

Adjustment on USB Key Reading

Some slight adjustment on the reading of USB Key had been done in this version. After the adjustment, there could be some **improvement in terms of memory usage** when running USB Key, causing lesser frequency to timeout or out of memory when running the system with USB Key.

User will have to **update all USB Key related tools** in order to work together with this version:

- AutoCount Accounting 2.0.13.131
- AutoCount USB Key Server 2.0.0.4
- AutoCount Server 2.0.2.116
