This summer, for the first time, the ESIP education committee would like to invite California educators to join us at our summer meeting on the UCSB campus to learn about ESIP Federation efforts to study and steward our planet. Participating G6-12 teachers will attend the ESIP introductory plenary for one morning followed by an afternoon and second full day of workshop sessions featuring hands-on computer activities and demonstrations of ways ESIP tools and data can be used in science classrooms. Sessions will be led by ESIP members from NOAA, NASA, EPA, USGS, CIMSS, TERC and other ESIP organizations.
