4. How to find Official Military Personnel Records (OMPF), Pension Applications, and Bounty Land Warrants

OMPF: CRITICAL KNOWLEDGE 1

Records are accessioned into the National Archives, and become archival, 62 years after the service member's separation from the military. This is a rolling date; hence, the current year, 2022, minus 62 years is 1960. Records with a discharge date of 1960 or prior are archival and are open to the public. Records with a discharge date of 1961 or after are non-archival and are maintained under the Federal Records Center program. Non-archival records are subject to access restrictions.

OMPF: CRITICAL KNOWLEDGE 2

On July 12, 1973, a disastrous fire at the NPRC destroyed approximately 16-18 million Official Military Personnel Files. The records affected:

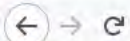

Recent military service and medical records are **not online**. However, most veterans and their next of kin can obtain **free copies** of their DD Form 214 (Report of Separation) and the following military service records any of the ways listed below.

What if I'm not the Veteran or next-of-kin? Can I still access files?

- It depends on the date** the service member separated from the military. Military personnel records are **open to the public 62 years after** they leave the military. (To calculate this, take the current year and subtract 62.) Records of any veteran who separated from the military 62 (or more) years ago can be ordered by **anyone** for a copying fee (detailed below under "cost"). See [Access to Military Records by the General Public](#) for more details.

But what if it's been less than 62 years?

- Records of individuals who left service **less** than 62 years ago are subject to access restrictions and only limited information or copies may be released to the general public within the provisions of the law. The [Freedom of Information Act \(FOIA\)](#) and the Privacy Act provide balance between the right of the public to obtain information from military service records and the right of the former military service member to protect his/her privacy. - ❑ **Military service at Fort Bliss in El Paso, Texas (family story)**
- ❑ **This 1920 US Census is the only on-line record of his military service**
- ❑ **Could not find any on-line record of draft card, enlistment, or discharge**
- ❑ **All the data is correct; this is him!**
- ❑ **I planned to request his military personnel file from the National Archives to find enlistment date, unit, discharge date, rank achieved, etc.**
- ❑ **But – in a box of papers from his desk, I found his discharge paper (Army: 1919-1922)**

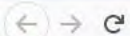
