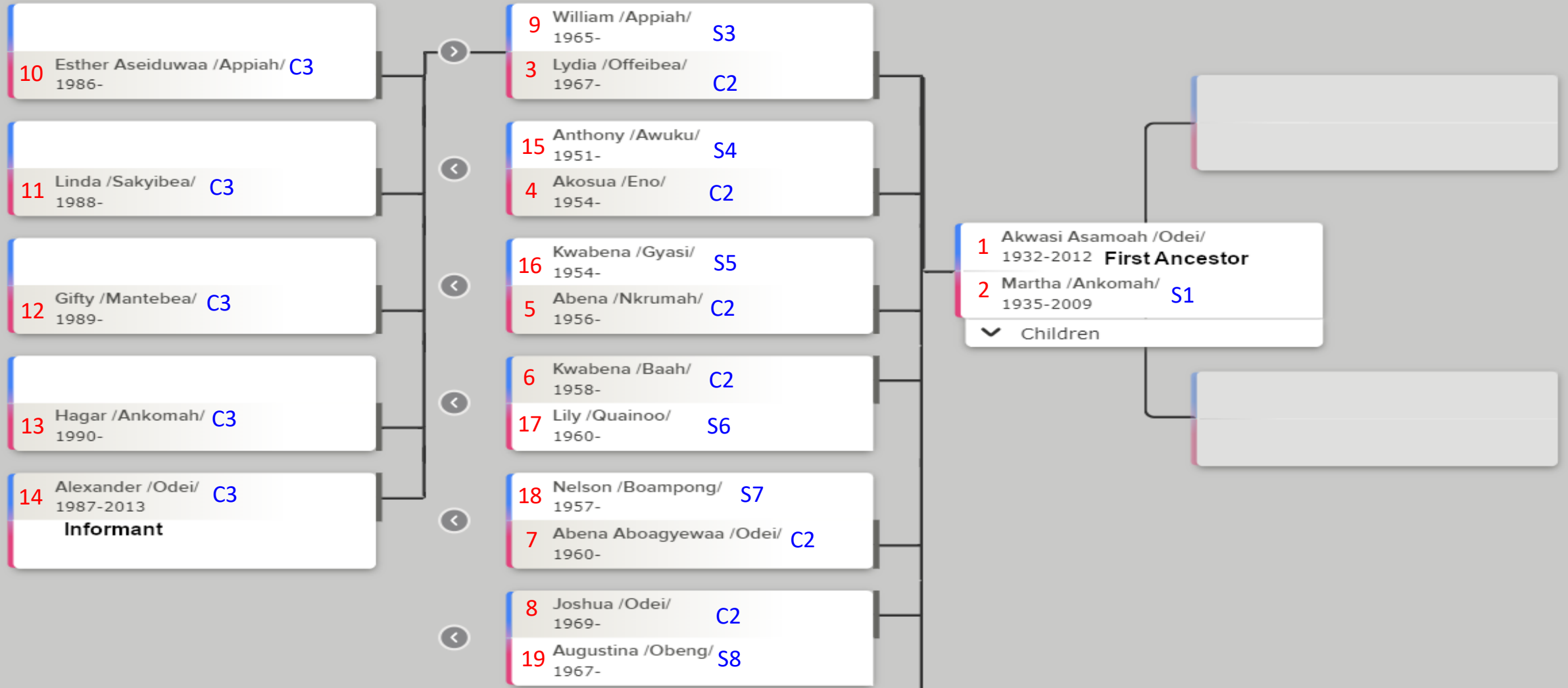

14	C3	M	Alexander Odei	Rules for Creating the Tree: 1. Starting with the First Ancestor, each name given by the informant is given a unique RIN #. Names should not be repeated. 2. Each person is given a relationship code (S or C) to explain their relationship to others in the tree. a. Spouse = S of Rin #. So the person who is the spouse of the first ancestor would be S1. b. Child = C of Rin # of the mother . So each person who is a child of the wife of the First Ancestor would be C2. 3. Locations should contain 4 levels and all 4 levels should be fully written out in the interview location box. Region and country may be abbreviated if these abbreviations are published and common knowledge. Village and District should never be abbreviated. Ditto marks (" ") may be used if the information immediately above is identical to what should be entered in the current box.
